

Donya Releases Heartbreak Pop Ballad "Deja Vu"

"Deja Vu" by Donya - Out May 29 on all major streaming platforms

Built around the hook *"Your haunted house is Deja Vu,"* the track pairs stripped-back production with diary-like vocal delivery. An official lyric video, built around the song's "haunted house" imagery,

accompanies the release.

The song explores the kind of heartbreak that doesn't fade when you think it has. Lyrics like *"You said I would never hurt you"* and *"Do broken hearts hang in your room?"* frame the track as a quiet, late-night conversation with someone who's already gone. It's slow, vulnerable, and built for the hours when everyone else is asleep.

Donya Dadrasan is an international pop artist known for emotionally direct songwriting and a strong visual identity in her music videos. After years of building a loyal pop audience, "Deja Vu" marks a more intimate, conversational chapter of her work.
