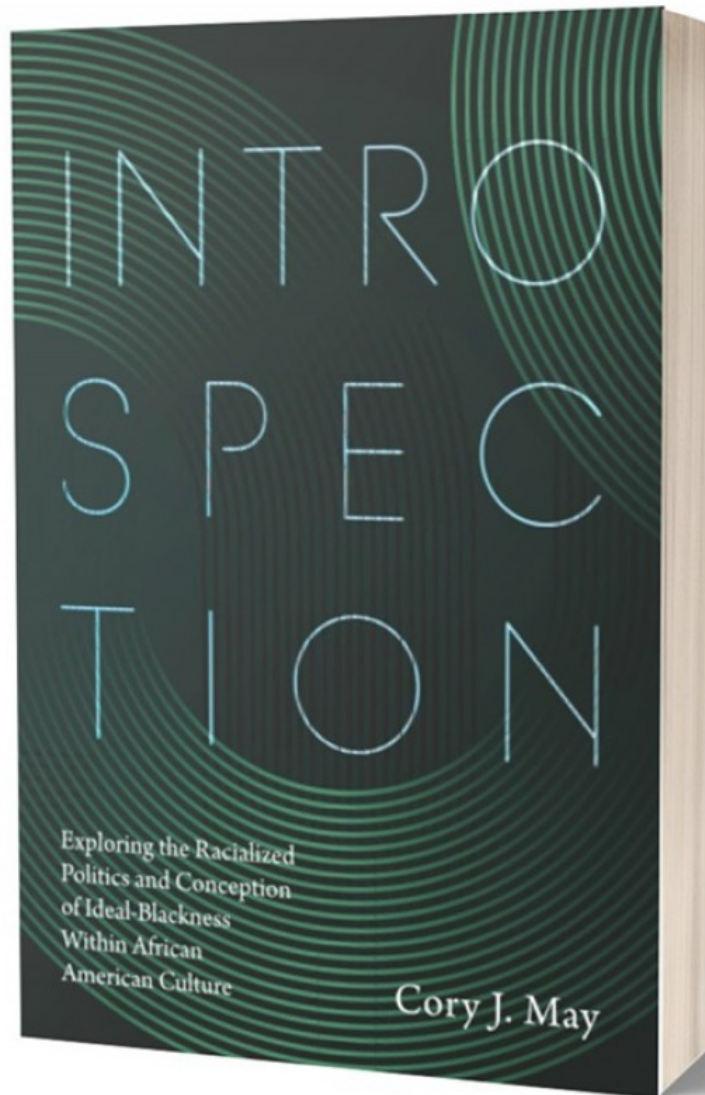


Dr. Cory J. May Releases New Book - Introspection
