

Joel Ney Raises Awareness for Local Animal Shelters and SPCA Organizations

Construction professional Joel Ney of Pine Grove, Pennsylvania, is encouraging stronger community support for local animal shelters and SPCA organizations through volunteerism, donations, and everyday action.

Ney, who has long supported local charities and SPCA organizations, says helping animals is an issue that often gets overlooked despite the growing pressure many shelters face.

“A lot of shelters are doing important work with limited resources,” Ney says. “Even small actions from people in the community can make a difference.”

Animal shelters across the United States continue to face overcrowding, rising operational costs, and increased demand for services. According to national animal welfare organizations, millions of animals enter shelters every year, while many local facilities rely heavily on volunteers and donations to continue operating.

For Ney, supporting these organizations is about responsibility and community involvement.

“I believe people should help where they can,” he says. “Not everybody has to do something huge. Sometimes donating supplies, volunteering time, or even spreading awareness can help more than people realize.”

Ney’s advocacy comes from his broader belief in consistency, hard work, and supporting the people and organizations that strengthen local communities. Outside of his work in construction and welding, he volunteers through his church, supports local youth sports teams, and contributes to charities that focus on both people and animals.

He says local shelters often operate quietly behind the scenes, even though their work has a visible impact on communities.

“These organizations are taking care of animals that need help every day,” Ney says. “A lot of people do not realize how much work goes into that.”

Animal welfare groups have also reported increases in pet surrenders in recent years due to economic pressures and housing challenges. Many shelters continue to need food donations, foster support, veterinary assistance, and volunteer labor.

Ney believes awareness starts at the local level.

“People usually think someone else will step in,” he says. “But communities get stronger when regular people decide to help.”

While Ney is not connected to a formal fundraising campaign, he hopes conversations around local support can encourage more people to get involved in ways that fit their abilities and schedules.

He also emphasizes that support does not always need to be financial.

“Sometimes it’s just giving a little time, helping share information, or supporting local events,” Ney says. “Small things add up.”

As someone who built his career through hands-on work and steady effort, Ney says he respects organizations that continue to operate under difficult conditions and with limited resources.

“That kind of work matters,” he says. “It takes commitment.”

Call to Action

Joel Ney encourages individuals and families to support local shelters and SPCA organizations by:

- Donating pet food, blankets, cleaning supplies, or other needed items
- Volunteering at local shelters or animal adoption events
- Fostering animals when possible
- Supporting local fundraising events and adoption drives
- Raising awareness for animal welfare efforts within their communities
- Adopting pets from shelters instead of purchasing from unverified sources

“Helping out locally can go a long way,” Ney says. “A strong community is built when people look out for others, including animals that need care.”
