Without Line Cutterz or some braid scissors, that's not particularly easy.

But these are not the only fishing tools you should keep on board; in addition to split ring pliers, fish grippers, and hook disgorgers, you should also carry a bait knife and filet knife, line nippers or scissors, jig eye cleaners, hook hones, spare hooks (including assist hooks) and line spooling tools, among others.

In short, if you need it in your home port for basic maintenance, it's a good idea to carry it on the water. A bad backlash that requires respooling, a deep hook, or a mess of line that needs to be cut quickly all require specialized fishing tools, and those you should not be without.
