

## Kyle Nunes Medeiros Meets Ward 13 Candidate Walled Khogali Ali in Regent Park on Toronto Affordability Crisis

Toronto housing affordability pressures drive civic-focused discussion between media creator and Ward 13 candidate on community equity, youth engagement, and voter priorities ahead of the municipal election.
