

MotoAssure Administration Expands Vehicle Service Contract Options for Pre-Owned and High-Mileage Car Buyers

Vehicle service contracts are a separate product category from manufacturer programs. A vehicle service contract is an optional, third-party agreement that drivers can purchase independently to help cover qualifying mechanical repairs after factory coverage ends. The expanded MotoAssure Administration lineup broadens access to these third-party service contracts for buyers whose vehicles fall outside OEM eligibility windows, including older trucks, classic vehicles, and everyday drivers with higher odometer readings.

With many factory programs capping eligibility at defined age and mileage thresholds, MotoAssure Administration is positioning its expanded vehicle service contract portfolio as a third-party alternative for the large and growing share of U.S. drivers who keep their vehicles well past the factory window.

Highlights of the expanded MotoAssure Administration portfolio include:

- Broader vehicle service contract eligibility for drivers researching an extended warranty for high mileage cars, with tiered MotoAssure Administration vehicle protection plans built around the realities of older drivetrains and electronic components.
- New vehicle service contract pathways for owners who have been searching for an extended car warranty for classic cars, offered as a third-party alternative with defined underwriting requirements around appraisals, documented maintenance history, and annual mileage limits.
- Specialized vehicle protection plan options for Ram truck owners, reflecting the growing share of half-ton and heavy-duty drivers who keep their trucks well past the factory window.
- A streamlined service contract quote process for shoppers who have been researching used car warranty quote options elsewhere, surfacing eligibility, plan tiers, and out-of-pocket structures in a single transparent comparison.

The high-mileage extended warranty cost question has been one of the most-searched topics among used-car buyers, and MotoAssure Administration vehicle protection plans are structured to give those shoppers pricing clarity at quote time rather than after a service request. MotoAssure Administration plan pricing varies by vehicle class, mileage band, plan tier, and out-of-pocket structure, and all four variables are surfaced up front so consumers can evaluate options on equal footing.

For classic vehicle owners, the new MotoAssure Administration vehicle service contract pathway reflects the specialty nature of the segment. Many classic and collector vehicles fall entirely outside factory eligibility, and until recently, third-party options for these owners were limited. The expanded classic-vehicle tier offers a dedicated MotoAssure Administration service contract built around how collector-car owners actually use their vehicles, with structured eligibility criteria covering appraisals, maintenance documentation, and annual mileage.

Truck owners gain additional pathways in the expansion as well. MotoAssure Administration's new vehicle service contract options target a segment where factory coverage frequently ends well before owners retire the vehicle. With many half-ton and heavy-duty Ram trucks staying in service past the 150,000-mile mark, MotoAssure Administration truck-segment service contracts give long-term drivers comparing ram truck extended warranty options a third-party alternative calibrated for trucks expected to keep working for years to come.
