Parents often notice changes before middle school begins, including nervousness about lockers, changing classes, making new friends, finding classrooms, handling homework, and fitting into a larger school environment. Many children do not openly talk about these worries, which can make the transition feel stressful for families. Ready for Middle School was developed to provide practical guidance, encouragement, and structure during this important transition period.
