His professional contributions extend well beyond clinical practice. Dr. Buch has been actively involved in implant design, regenerative medicine research, and the development of advanced orthopedic technologies, including customized 3D-printed knee replacements and innovative joint reconstruction techniques designed to improve patient outcomes and long-term functionality.

A Diplomate of the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery, Dr. Buch is also a Fellow of both the American College of Surgeons and the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons. The conference also reflects Dr. Buch's broader philosophy that medicine should foster mentorship, accessibility, and lifelong learning. Faculty members openly share resources and remain available to younger physicians for guidance and support long after the conference concludes.

Beyond his surgical and academic contributions, Dr. Buch has also demonstrated a longstanding commitment to community service. For more than two decades, he operated a free clinic in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, providing surgical care to underserved patients who otherwise lacked access to treatment.
