

Saasha Mangesh Raut Soars High with Record-Breaking Solo Paragliding Flight

9-Year-Old girl from Maharashtra Creates History as Youngest Paraglider Pilot

Nestled in the scenic Kangra district of Himachal Pradesh, Bir Billing is globally known for hosting international paragliding competitions and attracting pilots from around the world due to its ideal wind conditions and breathtaking mountain landscapes.
