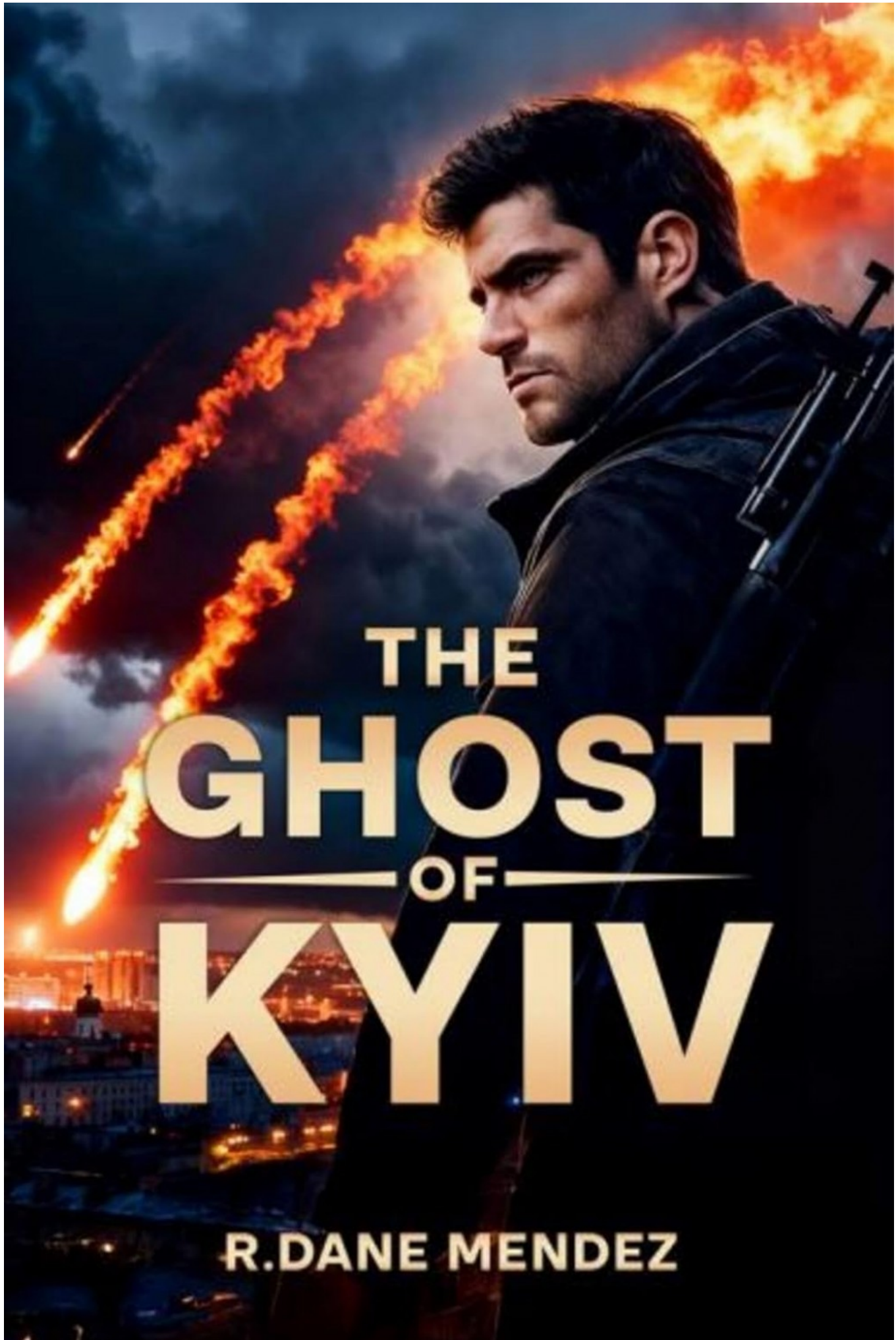


Shadows of Power: The Ghost of KYIV Delivers a Razor-Edged Exploration of Espionage, Vengeance, and the Cost of Peace
