

# St. Petersburg International Economic Forum 2026: “Pragmatic Dialogue” as a Lifeline for Global Business

From June 3 to 6, 2026, the Russian city of St. Petersburg will once again become the assembly point for the global economy.

The St. Petersburg International Economic Forum (SPIEF) will convene under the slogan “Pragmatic Dialogue — A Path to a Stable Future.” In an era where the world has definitively fragmented into macro-regions and the old rules of the game have ceased to function, foreign businesses are searching not merely for new markets, but for safe harbors offering predictable conditions. SPIEF 2026 promises to be precisely such a harbor.

## The Architecture of a New Reality

The forum’s business program is unabashedly ambitious. The organizers have prepared over 150 sessions, grouped into five thematic tracks. Judging by the program architecture published by the Roscongress Foundation, the emphasis is not on declarations, but on concrete agreements reached in focused circles.

The key track, “The Global Economy: Between Confrontation and Cooperation,” is a direct invitation to foreign investors. Discussions here will center on the transformation of global markets, the architecture of the future financial system, and new partnership formats. This is precisely where business can grasp how to build supply chains that bypass political barriers.

No less important is the track “Technologies Shaping the Future,” which will tackle issues of digital sovereignty, artificial intelligence, and robotization. For foreign tech companies, this is an opportunity to carve out a niche in a transforming industrial landscape.

## The Guest Country as an Investment Compass

This year, the guest country status has been awarded to Saudi Arabia. This is a landmark choice, reflecting a strategic vector aimed at deepening ties with the Global South. The Kingdom's national pavilion will serve as the central platform for presenting its investment potential. For foreign business leaders from Asia, the Middle East, and Latin America, this sends a clear signal: St. Petersburg welcomes those who are focused on real projects, regardless of geopolitical turbulence.

Representative delegations from 47 countries have already confirmed their participation. As Botirjon Asadov, the Ambassador of Uzbekistan to Russia, stated: "The St. Petersburg International Economic Forum is an authoritative international platform that offers additional opportunities to strengthen business contacts."

## Money Loves Silence — and St. Petersburg

Why does foreign business continue to travel to St. Petersburg despite the sanctions rhetoric? The answer lies in the numbers. At SPIEF 2025, over 1,060 agreements were signed, totaling approximately 6.3 trillion rubles. A significant portion of these contracts were cross-border deals.

Notably, the platform is becoming increasingly democratic. Alongside giants like Gazprom, representatives of small and medium-sized enterprises are acquiring their participant packages. For foreign entrepreneurs, including self-employed individuals from EAEU countries, special participation conditions are available starting from 25,000 rubles.

## A Takeaway for Decision Makers

SPIEF 2026 is not a gala dinner; it is a testing ground for verifying business hypotheses. For a foreign investor today, three things matter most: the speed of decision-making, guarantees of asset security, and direct access to the individuals shaping the economic policies of entire regions. The forum in St. Petersburg delivers all three.

While politicians argue, business signs contracts at SPIEF. And judging by the program and the lineup of participants, this year, pragmatic dialogue will definitively triumph over empty confrontation.
