

Sublime and Prism Water Pipes Launch Official Glassware Collaboration Celebrating Music, Culture, and Functional Design

The Sublime x Prism collection debuts May 5, 2026, with four modular beaker-style water pipes inspired by Sublime's iconic visual identity and enduring cultural influence, with a coordinating handpipe planned for a future release.

The [Sublime x Prism Official Collection](#) features four modular beaker-style water pipes, each designed to reflect Sublime's unmistakable visual identity while showcasing Prism's signature threaded modular design. The collection will expand with a coordinating handpipe as a future addition to the collection.

The collaboration represents a natural extension of Sublime's lifestyle and licensing platform, connecting the band's multigenerational fanbase with thoughtfully designed products rooted in music culture, self-expression, and adult-use lifestyle. Sublime-headlined shows will also feature signage with QR codes, allowing adult fans 21+ to learn more about the collection and shop directly online.

"This collaboration is a natural fit because Sublime has always been more than a band. It's a culture, a lifestyle, and a visual language that fans instantly connect with," said **Rebecca Maestas Sincere**,

Artist Partnerships Regime Music Group. “Prism understood how to honor that legacy while creating something functional, collectible, and distinctive for adult fans. It’s exactly the type of thoughtful lifestyle extension we look for when building licensed products around an iconic artist brand.”

The collection includes four classic beaker-style water pipes made from durable borosilicate glass, offered in two heights and two colorways. Each water pipe features Sublime’s iconic sun graphic on the base and the band’s name running up the mouthpiece.

The forthcoming coordinating clear sphere-style handpipe is designed to add a storytelling element to the collection through its dual-wall construction and visual reveal. As the chamber fills, smoke creates a cloud-like backdrop around the Sublime logo; as the piece is cleared, the clouds dissipate and the sun comes back into view, a subtle nod to the band’s unmistakable imagery and enduring sense of light, movement, and release.

“At Prism, we’re always looking for ways to push functional glassware forward while creating pieces people are proud to display,” said **Eliot Coven, VP of Sales at Prism Water Pipes.** “By combining Sublime’s iconic energy with Prism’s modular design, the collection gives fans a more personal way to engage with the band through pieces they can use, customize, collect, and make their own.”

A coordinating Sublime x Prism Handpipe is planned for a future release at \$65.

The collaboration launches during a major cultural year for Sublime, as the band celebrates the legacy of its groundbreaking self-titled album while entering a new era with new music, headline performances, and expanded fan experiences. The Sublime x Prism collection reflects the growing demand for artist-led lifestyle products that extend beyond traditional merchandise and give fans new ways to connect with the music, imagery, and culture they love.
