

2024 VP Candidate, Despite Audio-Recorded Threats To Stay Silent, Registers with FEC for 2028 Presidential Election

Child and Family Rights Advocate and Former 2024 VP Candidate Says It's Time To Return To Our Origins of Freedom and Respectful International Collaboration

Chattanooga, Tennessee Jun 27, 2026 (IssueWire.com) - Neal David Sutz, born in New York City to an American father and Swiss-Italian mother, officially announces his candidacy for President of the United States in the 2028 election and is officially registered with the FEC (FEC Candidate ID #P80009673 & FEC Committee ID #C00953323). With a life marked by resilience, advocacy, and unwavering commitment to justice, Sutz emerges as a powerful Independent voice for Americans seeking transparency, reform, government accountability, life affordability, and collaboration.

Raised between NYC, Arizona, and Washington D.C., Sutz began his career as a writer and mental health advocate, overcoming his own challenges with naturopathic-medication-induced, bipolar II disorder, from which he has been symptom-free for over 20 years. He published children's books used in school curricula in 1993 and achieved best-seller status with his 2003 book, *"Kick It With Gusto! A Practical Guide To Living Through Anxiety, Depression and Bipolar Disorder"* and proceeded to write, produce and direct a full-length documentary film on the current state of mental health care in *The USA*, as well as a biographical film exposing his own challenge and ultimate victory over mental illness.

His late father was the Assistant Director for Grumman Aircraft (now Northrop Grumman), in charge of Military Sales to The Middle East, in the 1950s and 1960s, based out of Geneva, Switzerland, later leading the Inventions Division at ERDA (Energy Research and Development Administration) in the 1970's in Washington, D.C. Sutz's father played a continual and major role within the Department of Energy at both the Arizona State and U.S. Federal levels, working primarily on classified military, energy and technology projects.

In 2004, Sutz gained international attention by suing [Dr. Phil](#), Oprah Winfrey, Paramount, et al under the Americans With Disabilities Act. The lawsuit demanded a legal disclaimer clarifying that Dr. Phil's TV advice was not professional mental health guidance. After extensive media coverage, including interviews on *Good Morning America* and *The Howard Stern Show*, the disclaimer was added. Three years later, Neal filed a \$100 million lawsuit when the disclaimer was removed, emphasizing his dedication to public accountability, before dropping the suit after correction.

Sutz's personal life took a harrowing turn in 2017 when his family sought refuge in Geneva, Switzerland, after turning over a controversial, child sexual exploitation video to Arizona Authorities. This led to severe retaliation from powerful family and political networks. Despite the 9-year, unlawful, alienating and ongoing detainment of his two sons, Sutz's eighty-four, baseless detainments by the Swiss Police for speaking out, as well as multiple legal battles across Swiss, American, and international courts, Sutz has remained a steadfast advocate for children's and family rights. He left Switzerland in 2023 due to ongoing, documented harassment from the Swiss Government, but continues to fight for justice for his family.

Addressing misconceptions about Sutz's 2028 Presidential run, Neal formerly served as the VP running mate to a protest candidate named, "Literally Anybody Else" in 2024 — a campaign that many viewed as a gimmick. In interviews in 2024, Sutz emphasized his focus on "collaboration, unity, children's rights, parents' rights, transparency, human trafficking, foreign relations collaboration and freedom of speech."

"My 2028 Presidential campaign is not a gimmick, quite to the contrary, nor an attack on President Trump, nor an attack upon any forthcoming GOP or DNC candidate," Sutz states. "It is born from decades of fighting for truth, justice, and the future of my children, all children, and all families."

Honoring his immigrant grandparents, late wife, late mother, and especially his two sons — whom he has not seen in over three years — Sutz dedicates his campaign to protecting children, family values, and restoring faith in government. His comprehensive, 21-point platform, to be fully released by June 30, 2026, at his Campaign's website, www.Sutz2028.com, addresses economic renewal, social equity, children's, parent's and elder rights, affordable healthcare, human-centered education, respectful foreign relations, and government accountability.

A living testament to integrity, Neal holds his second, six-year Arizona Department of Public Safety

Level 1 IVP Fingerprint Clearance Card, verified by rigorous FBI background checks. He campaigns as an Independent inspired by George Washington, America's original Independent president.

Sutz's slogan, "**CHILDREN AND FAMILY BEFORE ALL ELSE,**" highlights his unwavering commitment to prioritizing the well-being and rights of families nationwide, as well as respectful, collaborative and productive Foreign Relations.

"Sutz for President 2028 is a movement for all Americans who believe in freedom, safety, civil rights, justice, peace and opportunity," Sutz said. "Together, we can reclaim the promise of this great nation."
