The book is far more than a personal memoir. It also serves as an educational resource focused on heart health and prevention. Rohland emphasizes the importance of regular medical checkups, blood pressure monitoring, physical activity, and healthy lifestyle habits that can significantly reduce the risk of heart disease.

In addition, the book explores advances in cardiovascular medicine, including the development of modern artificial-heart technology. One chapter examines the BiVACOR artificial heart and the researchers working to develop solutions for millions of people worldwide suffering from severe heart disease.

Alongside these medical insights, *Heart and Miracles* offers a deeply personal spiritual journey. Through reflections on faith, resilience, forgiveness, and personal transformation, Rohland shares the most important lessons of his life.

The project is currently supported through crowdfunding, with funds dedicated to professional editing, proofreading, book design, illustrations, cover development, e-book production, and marketing.
