However, the intensity of pandemic-era healthcare contributed to professional burnout, leading him to reassess his long-term career direction.

In 2026, Davenport transitioned into occupational health at General Electric in Louisville, Kentucky, where he currently provides on-site medical care, emergency response, and employee health support within a manufacturing environment. This role allows him to continue applying his emergency nursing skills while working in a more structured and sustainable clinical setting.

A graduate of Galen College of Nursing in Louisville, Davenport completed an accelerated, year-round nursing program that prepared him for licensure and advanced clinical practice. He holds certifications in Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS), Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC), and the NIH Stroke Scale (NIHSS), reflecting his strong foundation in emergency and critical care nursing.

Looking ahead, Davenport remains committed to professional growth and lifelong learning. He plans to pursue his Bachelor of Science in Nursing and ultimately his Nurse Practitioner Degree within the next five years, continuing his dedication to expanding his clinical expertise and advancing patient care.
