ASM's operations are supported by a 24/7 team and a global service network covering more than 3,000 locations worldwide. Aircraft owners and operators often work with several separate providers for flight planning, permits, fuel, ground handling, crew services, passenger support, and aircraft operations. ASM's integrated model was developed to improve coordination, visibility, and accountability across these functions.

Through ASM and its licensed aircraft operating arm, [ASM Air](#), the group supports an "all under one roof" aviation model. This structure brings together global flight support, private aviation services, aircraft operations, and charter support under a coordinated framework. The approach is designed to help aircraft owners, operators, brokers, and corporate clients manage complex missions more efficiently and consistently.

Across his career, Mr. Gomes has led the business through multiple industry cycles, including economic downturns, regional disruptions, and the global impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. During periods of operational uncertainty, ASM continued to support international flight movements and strengthened its focus on private aviation, VIP, diplomatic, business, repatriation, and medevac missions across Europe, Africa, Asia, and the Middle East.
