

# Comcast Xfinity Data Breach Settlement Offers Claims Through September 14, 2026

Eligible U.S. residents who received a Comcast breach notice may file claims for cash payments, documented losses, and identity protection benefits under the proposed settlement.

**New York City, New York Jun 12, 2026 ([IssueWire.com](https://www.IssueWire.com))** - Comcast Xfinity customers who received a breach notice around December 18, 2023 may be eligible to seek benefits in the proposed Hasson v. Comcast Cable Communications LLC settlement, according to the official settlement website. The site currently lists September 14, 2026 as the claim deadline, with opt-out and objection deadlines of July 1, 2026. The official settlement website is [ComcastBreachSettlement.com](https://ComcastBreachSettlement.com).

The case is pending in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania as Hasson v. Comcast Cable Communications LLC, Case No. 2:23-cv-05039-JMY. The notice says the lawsuit concerns a third-party cyberattack in October 2023 in which unauthorized actors gained access to customer personal information, and Comcast denies wrongdoing.

Under the settlement, the class includes people residing in the United States and its territories who were sent individual notice that their information may have been compromised. In plain English, that means consumers who received the Comcast breach notice in late 2023 and were told they may have been affected by the incident.

If approved, Comcast will pay 117.5 million dollars into a settlement fund. According to the official materials, available benefits include reimbursement for documented out-of-pocket losses, compensation for up to five hours of lost time, alternative cash payments, and identity defense and restoration services. The website also states that valid claims may be adjusted on a pro rata basis depending on the number and value of claims submitted.

The official settlement website lists the final approval hearing for August 5, 2026 at 12:30 p.m. ET at the James A. Byrne U.S. Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19106. It also says claims must be submitted online or postmarked by September 14, 2026, while requests to opt out or object are due July 1, 2026.

Sparrow has published a plain-language summary of the settlement so readers can review publicly available deadlines, eligibility rules, and filing details in one place.
