The family foundation will consolidate these efforts under a formal structure, enabling the family to coordinate around shared priorities and build programs capable of outlasting individual involvement.

### **Foundation to Address Gaps in Access and Infrastructure**

The foundation's focus areas reflect Mangena's view that sustainable community change requires more than resource distribution. Programs will target pathways to stable livelihoods, connections to markets for local enterprises, and access to education and infrastructure in developing-world communities where the impact of targeted interventions can be transformational.

Mangena has drawn on board service with established charitable organizations to identify common patterns in how philanthropic programs succeed or fail. Initiatives that create perpetual external dependency rather than building local capacity, or that design programs based on assumed rather than confirmed community priorities, represent patterns the foundation intends to avoid.

Programs supported by the foundation will be evaluated against measurable outcomes, evidence of long-term sustainability, and alignment with priorities confirmed through direct community engagement.

### **Board Experience Informs Foundation Structure**

Mangena's involvement with multiple charitable boards has shaped the governance model he plans to apply. Engagement across organizations focused on education, economic development, and infrastructure has given him perspective on what approaches complement one another and what conditions lead to durable change in different contexts.

The foundation will coordinate giving around strategic priorities rather than responding to individual requests as they arise. This structure enables longer planning horizons and sustained engagement with target communities.

### **Geographic Focus on Developing Regions**

The foundation's primary geographic focus remains the developing world. Mangena's rationale is that the same level of resources can produce transformative change in communities that lack foundational infrastructure, whereas the same investment in more developed regions tends to yield only incremental improvement.

This focus does not exclude other regions but reflects where well-structured interventions are most likely to produce the level of change Mangena's programs are designed to achieve.
