been defined by a commitment to patient care, physician training, and community service. Since entering practice in 2010, Dr. Chaudhuri has combined clinical excellence with visionary leadership, helping expand healthcare access while developing innovative residency and fellowship programs that prepare future physicians to serve diverse and often underserved communities.

Dr. Chaudhuri currently serves as Chief Executive Officer of Seven Star Medical Group and Seven Star Hospital Associates, where she oversees a growing network of graduate medical education programs. Under her leadership, the organization supports residencies in internal medicine, family medicine, and transitional year training, as well as fellowship programs in endocrinology, infectious disease, and gastroenterology. Her work has played a significant role in strengthening physician workforce development throughout Southern California.

In 2013, Dr. Chaudhuri co-founded a hospitalist group that has since evolved into a comprehensive multi-specialty healthcare network. Today, the organization encompasses emergency medicine, anesthesia, primary care, general surgery, nephrology, and other specialties, reflecting her long-standing vision of delivering coordinated, community-based healthcare through collaborative physician leadership.

A proud native of Hemet, California, Dr. Chaudhuri's dedication to healthcare began at an early age. Born in Pennsylvania, she moved to Hemet with her family when she was three years old and attended Hemet Unified School District schools from kindergarten through high school. An accomplished student, she participated in California Girls State and Academic Decathlon before graduating as Valedictorian of Hemet High School's Class of 1999.

She went on to attend UCLA, where she majored in History while completing pre-medical coursework. During her undergraduate years, she was actively involved in community service through a co-ed service fraternity, served as an officer in the Asian Pacific Coalition, and participated on the Student Fee Advisory Committee, which advised the Chancellor on student-funded campus programs and services.

Following graduation, Dr. Chaudhuri earned her Medical Degree from Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. She completed her internship and residency training in internal medicine through programs affiliated with Cedars-Sinai Medical Center in Los Angeles and Northwestern in Chicago, experiences that helped shape both her clinical expertise and passion for medical education.

"I always knew I wanted to pursue a career where I could take care of patients in the hospital," Dr. Chaudhuri explains. "I remember as a child finding the hospital to be a distressing experience, but it also made me want to help other people going through similar situations and make their experience a little easier."

After residency, Dr. Chaudhuri moved to Milwaukee, where she worked as an internist and Associate Program Director for the Internal Medicine Residency Program at the Medical College of Wisconsin. In 2013, she and her husband, an ophthalmologist and Wisconsin native, returned to Southern California, where she joined the University of California, Riverside School of Medicine.

Following the birth of her identical twin sons, Dr. Chaudhuri focused her efforts closer to home, helping develop hospitalist and residency programs within her local community. Her passion for graduate medical education continued to grow, leading her into leadership roles that have allowed her to influence the training and mentorship of hundreds of future physicians.

Beyond healthcare administration and education, Dr. Chaudhuri remains deeply engaged in advocacy and public service. She currently serves as president-elect of the Riverside County Medical Association,

where she works to advance physician leadership and healthcare policy initiatives. She also served on the Hemet Unified School District Board from 2020 to 2023, helping guide the district through the unprecedented challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Her commitment to community extends through her service on the boards of the Healthy Valley Foundation and the Western Science Center, organizations dedicated to improving health, education, and quality of life throughout the region.

Through every stage of her career, Dr. Sumanta Chaudhuri Saini has remained committed to a singular mission: improving healthcare access while empowering the next generation of physicians. By combining clinical expertise, educational leadership, and community advocacy, she continues to make a lasting impact in the community she proudly calls home.
