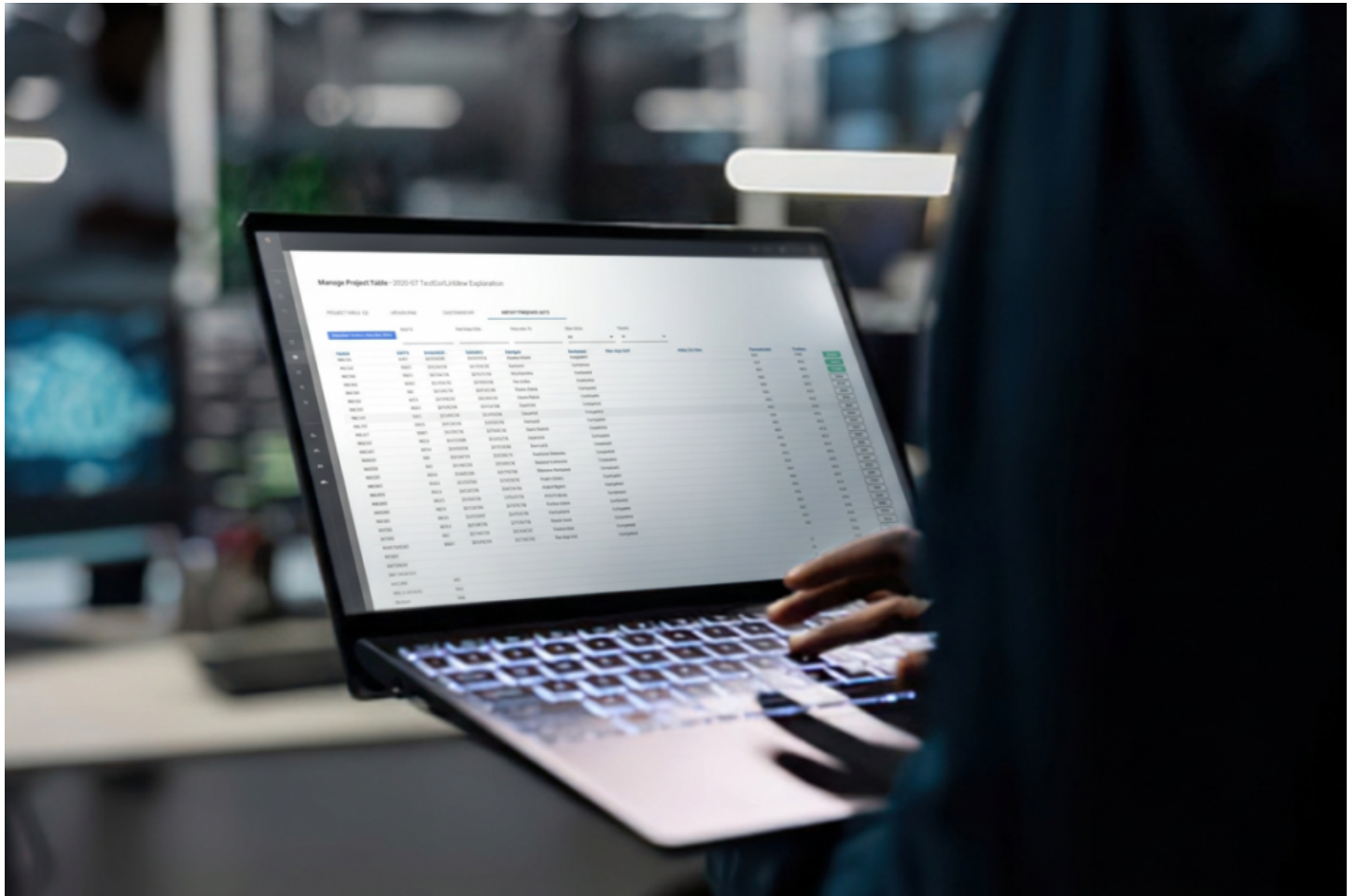


Acquire connects Blackfox and GIM Suite to bring geology and drilling data together

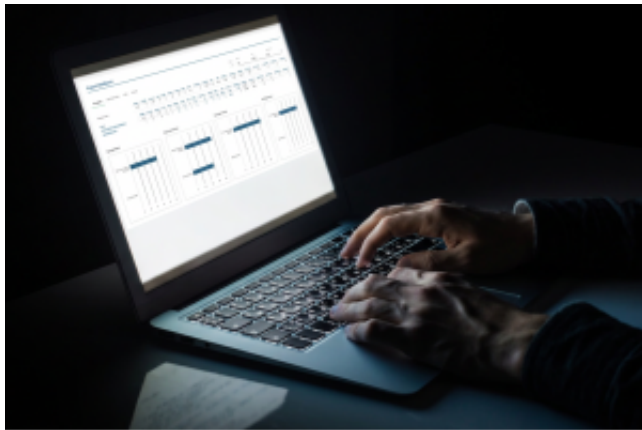
