Chief Technology Officer Rituraj Pankaj named among the Top Cyber Leaders to Watch in 2026 on the CS26 list published by the Cyber Revolution Summit India

The company's Chief Technology Officer, Rituraj Pankaj, has been named among the Top Cyber Leaders to Watch in 2026. The recognition appears on the CS26 list. The CS26 list honours cybersecurity leaders from across the country. The recognition matters because logistics has changed. Modern supply chains run on software.

Warehouses use scanners, sensors, and robots. Trucks share live location data. Orders, invoices, and stock records move through connected systems every second. This is why cybersecurity in logistics has become a core business need. A single breach can halt dispatches, expose client records, and delay goods across many cities at once. Attacks on supply chain firms have grown worldwide in recent years, which has pushed the sector to act.

At AWL India, Rituraj Pankaj leads this work. His team builds and protects the company's digital platforms. These include SWIM, the warehouse management system, and CHAKSHU, the IoT-based shipment tracking tool. His role also covers [infrastructure cybersecurity](#) across warehouse networks, cloud servers, and data systems. The focus areas include access control, network monitoring, staff awareness, and quick response to threats. The goal is to keep operations running and client data safe at the same time.

"Security is not a project with an end date. It is a daily habit," said Rituraj Pankaj, Chief Technology Officer, AWL India. "Our clients trust us with their stock and their data. That trust has to be earned every day. This recognition belongs to the entire technology team at AWL India. Threats keep changing, so we keep learning."

Strong security also supports routine warehouse work. Clients and industry peers often ask one common question. How does AWL India ensure prevention of stockouts and efficient inventory replenishment in its warehouses? The answer starts with reliable data. The SWIM platform tracks stock levels in real time. The AQUARIUM analytics tool studies demand patterns and flags items before they run low. Teams then reorder at the right time. This process depends on data that is accurate and safe from tampering. Secure systems make that possible. In this way, cyber protection and daily operations support each other.

The honour also points to a wider shift in [logistics management](#). Speed and cost still matter. But clients now also ask about data safety, system uptime, and legal compliance. Service providers that treat security as part of daily operations are better placed to meet these needs. Recognitions like CS26 help highlight the people doing this work.

Rahul Mehra, Founder and Chairman of AWL India, shared his views on the recognition.

"This is a proud moment for all of us at AWL India," said Rahul Mehra. "Rituraj has built our technology with patience and care. He has always treated client data as a duty, not just an asset.
