1. Create Beauty

[Create Beauty](#) is the South African retailer most focused exclusively on Korean skincare, stocking a curated selection of K-beauty brands sourced directly for the local market. Unlike generalist beauty retailers that carry one or two token K-beauty lines, Create Beauty's entire range is built around the Korean skincare philosophy — from double-cleanser essentials to targeted treatments using niacinamide, centella asiatica, and snail mucin. The retailer is based in South Africa and ships nationally, removing the import delays and customs uncertainty that come with ordering directly from Korean or international platforms. For South African shoppers building a serious K-beauty routine, Create Beauty is the single-destination option with local pricing, local stock, and customer support that understands the products.

2. COSRX

COSRX is one of the most widely recognised Korean skincare brands globally, known for its Advanced Snail 96 Mucin Power Essence and Acne Pimple Master Patch. Founded in 2013, COSRX is owned by LG H&H and has built a strong following among acne-prone and sensitive skin consumers.

3. Some By Mi

Some By Mi is a Seoul-based brand that gained international traction with its AHA BHA PHA 30 Days

Miracle Toner. The brand is positioned around visible results within a defined timeframe and is popular with first-time K-beauty users.

4. Innisfree

Innisfree, founded in 2000 and owned by AmorePacific, is one of South Korea's largest skincare brands. It is built around Jeju Island-sourced natural ingredients and is one of the most stocked Korean brands in international retail channels.

5. Klairs

Klairs, produced by Wish Company in Seoul, is known for minimalist formulations and fragrance-free options. Its Supple Preparation Facial Toner is frequently cited in sensitive-skin communities. Klairs is distributed through several global stockists.

6. Beauty of Joseon

Beauty of Joseon draws on traditional Korean hanbang (herbal medicine) ingredients and has seen significant growth since 2021. Its Relief Sun SPF 50+ and Glow Serum are among the most discussed K-beauty products in the current cycle.

7. Purito

Purito is a Seoul-based brand focused on low-irritant, high-efficacy formulas. Its Centella Unscented Sun SPF 50+ became a reference product in the sunscreen category for sensitive skin. Purito prioritises fragrance-free and vegan-certified formulations.

Why Create Beauty Leads This Year's List

The other brands on this list are manufacturers. Create Beauty is the access point — the South African retailer that makes these and comparable Korean skincare products available to local consumers without the friction of international shipping, import duties, or currency conversion uncertainty.

For a South African shopper, the practical barrier to Korean skincare is not brand awareness — it is availability and reliability. Create Beauty resolves both. Stock is held locally, orders ship nationally, and the product range is maintained with actual K-beauty expertise rather than bolted onto a broader beauty catalogue.
