

Clutch Ranks GeekyAnts No.1 Among App Development Companies in California, USA

These placements represent positions within Clutch's directories, not industry-wide awards. Clutch says its ranking methodology considers verified client reviews, service focus, work experience, market presence, and ability to deliver. The platform discloses that it may receive fees for some placements and updates directory positions as company and review data change.

GeekyAnts holds a 4.8 rating across 115 Clutch reviews. Its profile records scores of 4.8 for quality, 4.8 for schedule, 4.7 for cost, and 4.9 for willingness to refer. Client review themes include delivery, work quality, communication, flexibility, and project management.

Buyers need to examine architecture depth, integration experience, security controls, and delivery governance alongside design and development capabilities.
