

# Controversial People Search Platform PersonPages Faces Backlash Over Global Background Lookup Capabilities

Critics say the platform makes it too easy to uncover personal information—including salaries, public criminal records, and online profiles—while supporters argue it simply aggregates publicly available data.



PersonPages, a global people search platform, is drawing increasing attention—and criticism—for making it possible to search for individuals across multiple countries and access publicly available information in one place.

The platform allows users to search for people by name and may surface information such as public salary records (where legally available), court and criminal records, property ownership, social media profiles, contact details, and even indications of online or dating site presence when those records are publicly discoverable.

Privacy advocates argue that tools like PersonPages make it easier than ever for strangers, employers, neighbors, or acquaintances to build detailed profiles on individuals within minutes. Some critics have called for tighter regulation of data aggregation services, saying they increase privacy risks despite relying on publicly available sources.

Supporters, however, contend that PersonPages does not access private databases or hack personal accounts. Instead, the company says it indexes and organizes information that is already publicly accessible, saving users the time of searching across dozens of separate websites and public record databases.

The controversy highlights a growing global debate over where to draw the line between public information and personal privacy. As data becomes increasingly accessible online, services that aggregate public records continue to face scrutiny from regulators, privacy organizations, and the public alike.

PersonPages states that individuals who wish to reduce their online footprint can request the removal of eligible information from its search results, in accordance with applicable laws and company policies.
