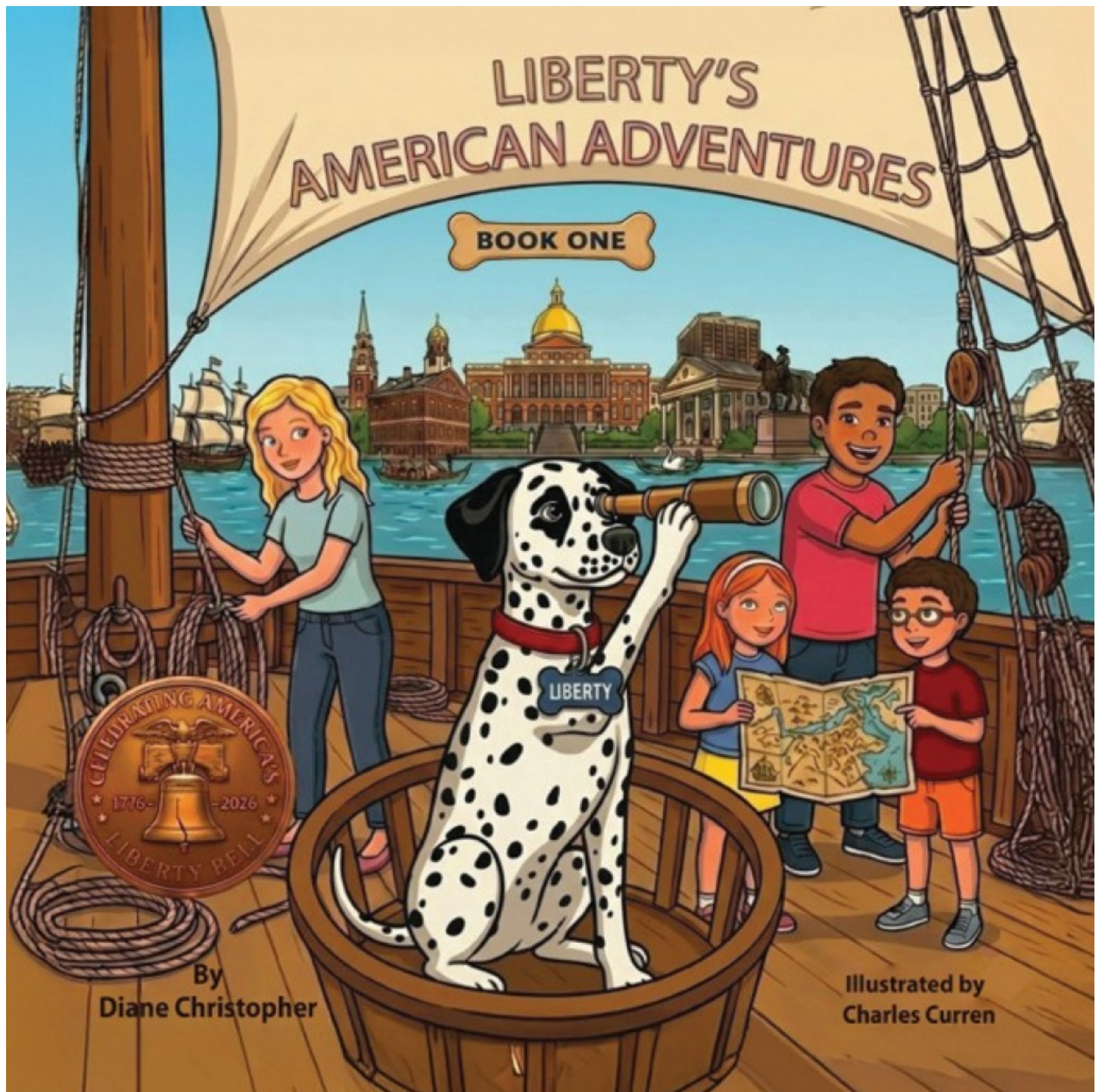


Diane Christopher's *Liberty and the Boston Adventure* Brings Revolutionary-Era Boston to Life Through a Dalmatian's Tale
