The company uses core aeration when soil conditions are physically limiting lawn growth.

That distinction matters because weak turf can also result from shade, drainage problems, disease, irrigation gaps, insect activity, or improper mowing practices. Core aeration should be recommended when soil compaction is part of the problem, not as an automatic treatment for every struggling lawn.

Evo Lawn & Landscape evaluates the property condition before recommending service.

How Core Aeration Works

Core aeration uses hollow tines to remove small plugs of soil and turf from the lawn.

The openings created during the process can help improve:

- Air movement through the root zone
- Water infiltration into the soil
- Nutrient movement
- Root development conditions
- Soil contact when lawn overseeding is added

The removed soil plugs are normally left on the lawn, where they gradually dry and break apart.

Core aeration differs from spike aeration because it removes soil instead of only pushing into the ground.

Compaction May Affect Only Certain Lawn Areas

Soil compaction is not always spread evenly across an entire Libertyville property.

One section of a lawn may remain dense and healthy while another repeatedly becomes thin because it receives more traffic or equipment pressure.

Areas that may be more vulnerable include:

- Gates
- Walkways
- Patios
- Play areas
- Pet routes
- Mower turning areas
- Turf near sidewalks and driveways
- Areas affected by construction or equipment traffic

A compacted section does not automatically mean the entire property requires the same level of treatment.

How Libertyville Homeowners Can Check for Possible Compaction

Homeowners can perform a basic test when the soil is moist but not saturated.

A screwdriver or garden probe can be pushed several inches into different areas of the lawn.

If one section requires significantly more force than another, the harder area may have greater soil compaction.

Homeowners can also observe how water behaves during irrigation or rainfall.

Water that moves across firm soil before soaking in may indicate weak surface infiltration.

Persistent standing water is different. It may point to grading, drainage, or saturated soil problems that core aeration will not correct.

Core Aeration and Lawn Overseeding Serve Different Purposes

Lawn overseeding is available as an add on when the existing turf remains viable but needs improved density.

Core aeration improves the soil environment.

Lawn overseeding introduces new grass seed into the established lawn.

The two services can work together, but they should not automatically be treated as one required package.

A dense lawn with compacted soil may need core aeration only.

A thin lawn may benefit from core aeration with lawn overseeding added.

The aeration openings can provide additional areas where seed reaches exposed soil instead of remaining suspended above the turf canopy.

Overseeding Should Not Be Automatic

Evo Lawn & Landscape does not recommend lawn overseeding for every aerated property.

The company first considers why the lawn became thin.

Possible causes include:

- Heavy shade
- Poor drainage
- Inadequate irrigation
- Excessive traffic
- Active disease
- Insect damage

- Improper mowing
- Poor establishment from earlier seeding

Applying new seed without addressing the underlying problem may lead to weak or temporary results.

For example, repeatedly overseeding an area with insufficient sunlight does not change the amount of sunlight reaching the turf.

Spring Treatments Can Affect Overseeding Decisions

Before recommending lawn overseeding, Evo Lawn & Landscape considers what has already been applied to the property.

Some preemergent and herbicide treatments may interfere with grass seed germination.

A homeowner should not assume that overseeding is appropriate simply because core aeration is being performed.

Spring core aeration may still be appropriate when compaction is severe and the turf is actively growing.

Fall can provide a cleaner opportunity for lawn overseeding when turf growth, soil conditions, and seasonal timing are suitable.

Watering Is Critical After Lawn Overseeding

When lawn overseeding is added, homeowner watering becomes a major part of the establishment process.

Different areas of the same Libertyville property may dry at different rates.

Sunny turf near sidewalks and streets may dry faster because of direct sun, wind, and reflected heat.

Shaded backyard turf may retain moisture longer.

Sloped areas may experience runoff before enough water reaches the soil.

There is no single watering schedule that works for every property.

Watering frequency should reflect:

- Sun exposure
- Soil conditions
- Slope
- Wind
- Rainfall

- Sprinkler output
- Existing moisture levels

The goal is to prevent newly seeded areas from repeatedly drying out during germination and early growth.

Property Access Can Affect the Service Area

Backyard access matters when planning core aeration service.

The equipment needs a safe path to reach the lawn.

Gate width, tight turns, steep slopes, retaining edges, narrow passages, and other obstacles can determine whether the entire property can be serviced.

When backyard access is too narrow or unsafe, aeration may need to be limited to the front lawn and accessible side areas.

What Homeowners Should Mark Before Service

Core aerator tines enter the soil, so private underground features should be marked before service.

Homeowners should identify:

- Sprinkler heads
- Irrigation valve boxes
- Invisible pet fence wires
- Low voltage lighting wires
- Shallow drainage components
- Drain covers
- Recently installed underground features

The lawn should also be cleared of hoses, toys, branches, furniture, pet waste, and other objects that could interfere with safe equipment operation.

Core Aeration Will Not Correct Drainage Failures

Core aeration may help water enter compacted upper soil more effectively.

It will not fix:

- Improper grading

- Failed drainage systems
- Saturated subsoil
- Water entering from neighboring properties
- Repeated flooding
- Long term standing water

When water repeatedly collects in the same area or reaches structures, the problem should be treated as a drainage issue rather than relying on aeration alone.
