

Family, Sacrifice, and Survival: 'My Sister My Twin' by Linda McClung at BIBF 2026

Explora Books presented Linda McClung's *My Sister My Twin* at the 2026 Beijing International Book Fair (BIBF), held June 17–21 at the China National Convention Center (CNCC) in Beijing.



Vancouver, British Columbia Jul 28, 2026 (Issuewire.com) - Marking both the fair's 40th anniversary and its 32nd edition, BIBF brought together over 1,700 exhibitors from 82 countries and regions and welcomed about 300,000 visitors, reaffirming its role as Asia's leading platform for

international publishing exchange and cross-cultural dialogue.

Held under the theme “Using Books as a Medium to Facilitate Communication and Dialogue, Leading to Cooperative Success for All Parties Involved,” this year’s fair highlighted the role of storytelling in fostering understanding across cultures and perspectives. Within that setting, *My Sister My Twin* was presented as part of Explora Books’s showcase of titles exploring personal resilience, human connection, and transformation.

The novel follows fraternal twins Kate and Alex, whose long-standing rivalry is challenged when Alex is diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia. As Alex undergoes treatment and Kate faces a separate crisis after being abducted and held captive, both sisters are forced to confront years of resentment and misunderstanding. Through their parallel struggles, McClung explores how sacrifice, honesty, and compassion can reshape fractured relationships.

A pivotal moment in the novel occurs when Kate anonymously donates bone marrow to her sister, despite their difficult history. The decision becomes a turning point in the narrative and opens the possibility of reconciliation between the two women.

Faith remains a recurring element throughout the story, shaping how both characters respond to illness, uncertainty, and hardship. Whether through Scripture, reflection, or perseverance, the novel presents belief as one of the ways the sisters navigate difficult circumstances.

McClung’s professional experience as a nurse informs the novel’s portrayal of survival under pressure. Kate’s ability to endure captivity and respond to crises is grounded in practical knowledge and lived experience, adding realism to the story’s high-stakes moments.
