

Galadari Brothers Takes Home Seven Wins at CMME 2026



Dubai, United Arab Emirates Jul 16, 2026 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - It turned out to be a pretty big night for [Galadari Brothers' Heavy Equipment](#) Division at this year's Construction Machinery Middle East (CMME) Awards.

Held at the Ritz-Carlton JBR on June 25, the event brought together just about everyone in the industry, from equipment manufacturers to distributors and contractors. Among all of them, [Galadari stood out, picking up seven awards](#) across different categories.

A Bit of Everything, And It Paid Off

What makes this win interesting is the spread. It wasn't just one product line or one segment doing well; the recognition came from across the division's different businesses.

JCB Continues to Deliver

Through GB Equipment Solutions, JCB equipment once again proved why it's so widely used across job sites here.

They picked up:

OEM of the Year – Earthmoving

Backhoe Loader of the Year for the JCB 3CX

plus an **Honorable Achievement** for the JCB 520X

The 3CX, in particular, is already a familiar sight on UAE projects, so this didn't come as much of a surprise. It's one of those machines operators tend to stick with because it just gets the job done without unnecessary complexity.

A Strong Win in Heavy Transport

From Galadari Commercial Vehicles' side, the SITRAK G7H 6A-4 took home the **Dumper/Hauler/Mining Truck of the Year**.

That category is always competitive, especially given how demanding operating conditions can be in the region. The win reflects how well the truck holds up in real-world use, not just on specs, but day-to-day reliability.

Big Machines, Big Impact

Then came the heavy equipment segment, where Galadari picked up three more awards:

Komatsu PC 2000 – Mining Shovel / Excavator of the Year

Komatsu WA470-6 – Wheel Loader of the Year

Genie S-85 XC E – Electric Access Machine of the Year

The Komatsu machines are, frankly, built for scale, the kind you see on massive sites where downtime simply isn't an option.

The Genie win is also worth noting. Electric machines are slowly becoming more common here, and this shows the shift is actually happening, not just being talked about.

More Than Just a Good Night

Seven awards is impressive, but it also says something bigger about how Galadari operates.

Instead of focusing on a single brand or niche, the division has built a mix: JCB, Komatsu, SITRAK, and Genie, each covering a different need. That strategy seems to be working.

It also helps that they've been in the market long enough to understand what contractors here actually care about: reliability, service support, and machines that can handle heat, dust, and long hours.

Looking Ahead

With infrastructure and development projects continuing across the UAE and the wider region, demand for heavy equipment isn't slowing down any time soon.

If anything, it's getting more competitive.

This year's wins put Galadari in a strong position, but in this industry, it's less about one night and more about consistency over time.
