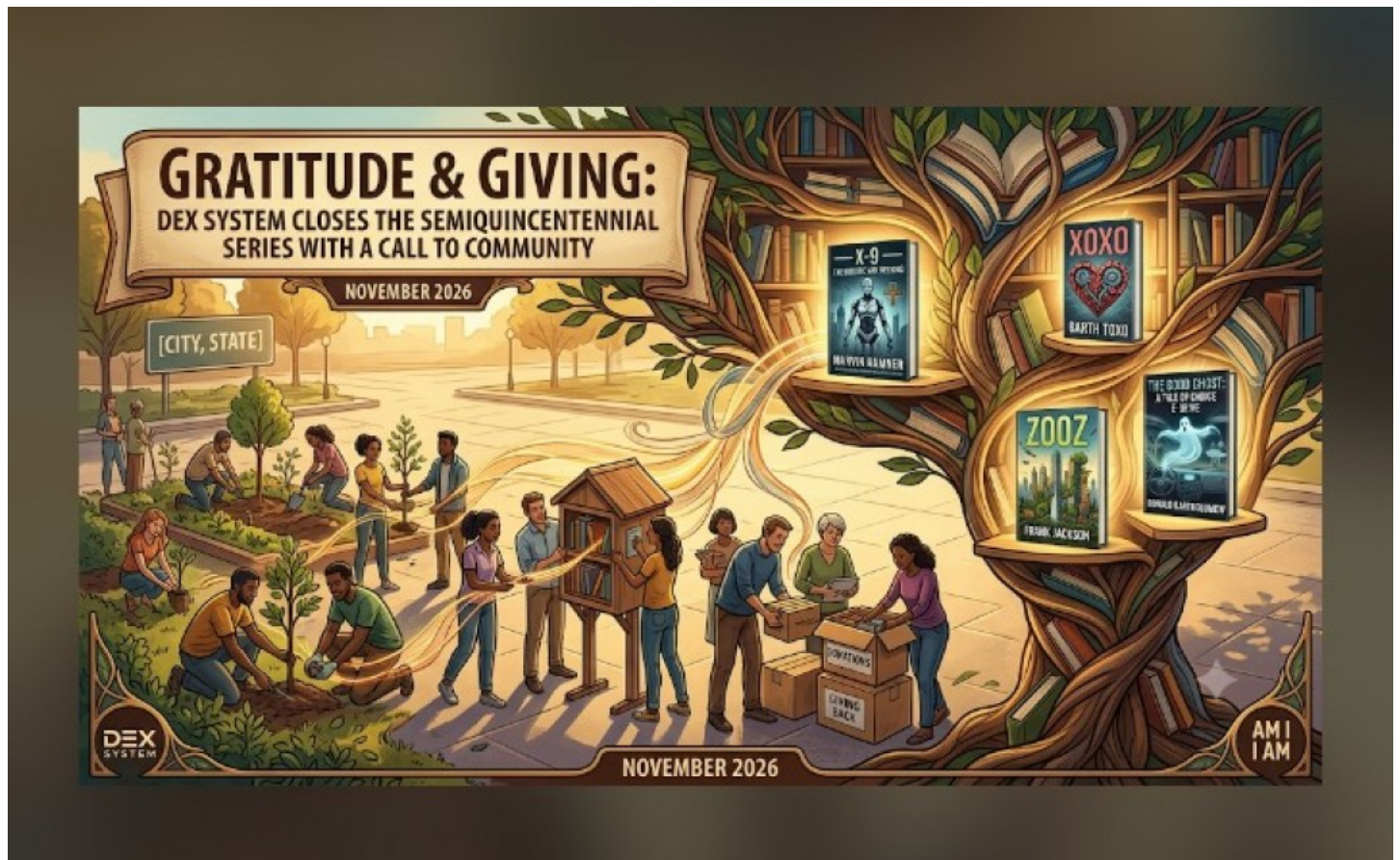


Gratitude & Giving: Dex System Closes the Semiquincentennial Series with a Call to Community

The final release ties the anniversary's theme of national service to Dex System's catalog

Fitting, given where the series started — with grills and fireworks — and where it ends: with a quieter kind of celebration built on care for others. This final release pairs that spirit of giving with three titles that explore connection, transformation, and legacy.

Marvin Hamner's *X-9 — The Robotic Van Helsing* and Garth Toxo's *XOXO* both explore protection and care in unconventional forms, imagining guardianship as something that can take shape in machines, monsters, or the unlikeliest of allies. Frank Jackson's *Zooz* rounds out the campaign on a note of resilience and renewal, a story of coming back from loss that mirrors the arc of the series itself — from spectacle, to reflection, to gratitude.
