The guide includes sections on building character names around role and story weight, making invented names pronounceable before making them impressive, creating place and faction names, avoiding the generic fantasy trap, and handling fast tabletop moments when players unexpectedly ask a guard, merchant, noble, cleric, or tavern staff member for a name.

A dedicated tabletop section gives game masters a practical non-player character naming kit for common fantasy roles. The resource also points readers toward related Name Generator X fantasy naming tools and guides, including fantasy, [D&D-style](#), [elf](#), [tiefling](#), dragonborn, dwarf, orc, halfling, gnome, wizard, dragon, and druid name resources.
