Ocean cargo remains the foundational method for heavy and high-volume commercial imports from Asia to North America. Recognizing that different businesses require different cargo capacities, Senghor Logistics offers structured Less than Container Load (LCL) and Full Container Load (FCL) options from major Chinese maritime gateways, including Shenzhen, Guangzhou, Ningbo, and Shanghai. The LCL service accepts shipments starting at a minimum volume of one cubic meter (1CBM), allowing small and medium enterprises to manage inventory costs without the financial burden of paying for unused container space. For larger volume requirements, FCL services provide dedicated container utilization to optimize cost-per-unit metrics.

For time-sensitive maritime cargo, the firm utilizes premium express channels, such as Matson shipping routes to the United States West Coast. This specific ocean service yields significantly shorter transit periods compared to standard maritime routing, bridging the gap between traditional ocean freight and costly air transport. Once the vessel arrives at the destination port, the company handles the entire customs clearance procedure and organizes direct inland delivery to warehouses across the United States. Furthermore, the specialized customs team possesses extensive experience in handling complex regulatory requirements for specific product categories, such as assisting clients with the necessary Lacey Act declarations and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) documentation required for commercial furniture imports.

Structured Air Freight and Capacity Management

When supply chains demand rapid replenishment to meet tight retail deadlines or sudden market demands, air transport becomes essential. To secure predictable space allocations during peak commercial periods, the company maintains direct contracts with major airlines and operates scheduled weekly cargo services. This regular allocation ensures that shippers can access air transport capacity without experiencing unexpected delays at the terminal.

The service accommodates various shipment sizes, with standard air freight options starting from a minimum weight threshold of 45 kilograms to 100 kilograms. Because cost efficiency remains critical in high-speed logistics, the logistics team evaluates multiple air routes and flight schedules to present clients with tiered pricing and speed options. By analyzing factors such as direct flights versus hub transfers, the company assists buyers in selecting the optimal balance between transit speed and financial expenditure.

Comprehensive Consolidation and Value-Added Services

Modern procurement often requires sourcing components or finished goods from multiple manufacturing facilities spread across different industrial zones in China. To optimize shipping efficiency and reduce per-shipment costs, Senghor Logistics operates dedicated storage and consolidation facilities near primary Chinese ports. This includes an expansive 18,000-square-meter warehouse facility located near the Yantian port in Shenzhen. Through these hubs, the company provides cargo consolidation services, receiving smaller shipments from various suppliers and combining them into unified containers for

international transit.

Because regulatory and administrative requirements often delay international shipments, the enterprise provides target assistance with origin documentation and special product profiles. The operational team possesses specific experience navigating the compliance frameworks for sensitive product categories, including cosmetics and electronic vaporizers, ensuring that appropriate safety documentation accompanies the cargo. To further streamline the import process, the company prepares relevant documentation, including Certificates of Origin, which help verify compliance with trade agreements and assist importers in managing applicable customs duties accurately.

Standardized Process Management and Logistics Visibility

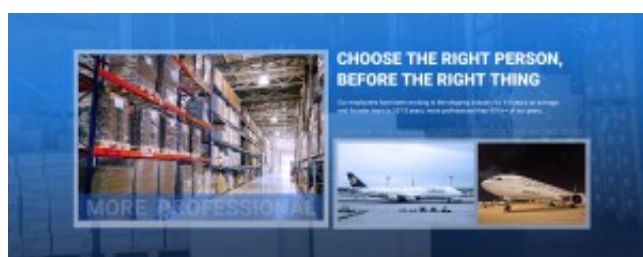
To maintain service consistency and ensure operational predictability, the company utilizes a structured seven-step workflow for managing transpacific cargo movements. The process begins with an inquiry and analysis phase, during which the logistics team reviews the client's cargo specifications, weight, volume, and urgency. Following this, the team develops one to three distinct routing and pricing proposals, allowing the client to choose the most efficient option for their budget.

Once a plan is selected, the company arranges domestic pick-up from the manufacturing plant and checks cargo integrity upon arrival at the consolidation warehouse. The documentation team then handles export customs brokerage formalities with Chinese customs authorities. For the international transit phase, cargo moves via ocean, air, or express channels, with real-time tracking facilitated through Ocean Bill of Lading or Air Waybill reference numbers. Upon arrival, licensed brokers manage import documentation at the U.S. port of entry to prevent administrative delays. Finally, the logistics network coordinates final-mile transport and schedules delivery appointments directly with the recipient's warehouse or fulfillment center, utilizing proactive communication channels to keep clients updated at every critical transition point.

Managing international transport requires a balance of infrastructure, regulatory knowledge, and practical execution.
