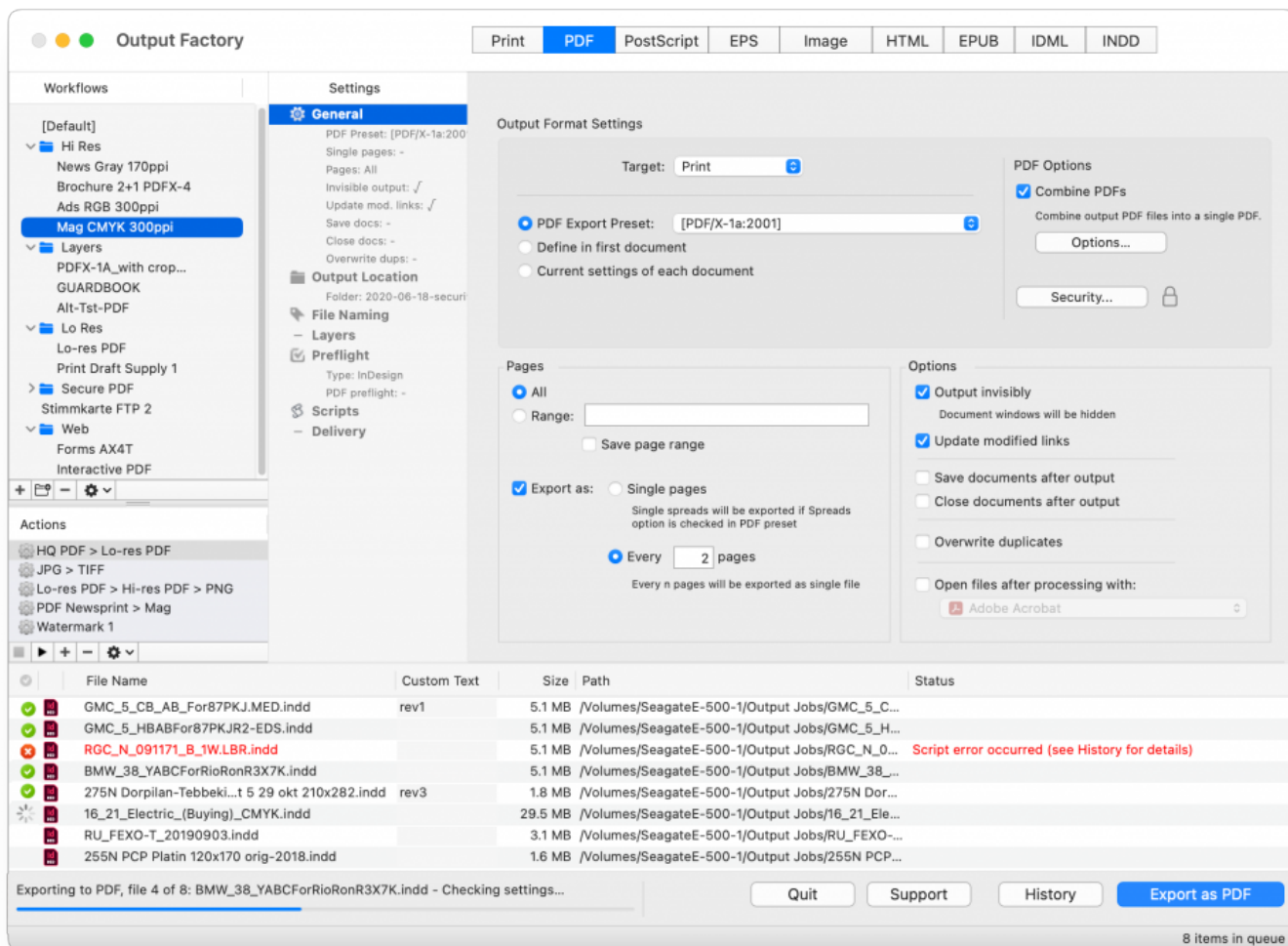


Output Factory for Adobe InDesign Restores PDF Merge Functionality

Zevrix Solutions announces Output Factory 3.2.4, a bugfix update to the company's output automation powerhouse for Adobe InDesign. The update restores the ability to automatically combine PDF files produced from batches of InDesign documents.

Output Factory eliminates the time-consuming repetitive tasks that publishers and printers face when printing and exporting InDesign documents to PDF, JPEG, EPUB, and other formats.

The update restores the ability to [combine individual output PDF files automatically after exporting batches of InDesign documents](#). This feature was disabled by accident but the bug was promptly identified and fixed. The PDF merge capability saves InDesign users hours of manual post-processing by automatically combining separate PDF pages or documents into a single, cohesive file.

In addition, the new version fixes a bug with the feature that [automatically inserts the InDesign image link name into output file names](#). In rare cases, it was only using the first letter of the image name

instead of the full name. This powerful option saves InDesign users significant time, reduces the chance of human error, and makes file organization much easier by eliminating the need for manual renaming.

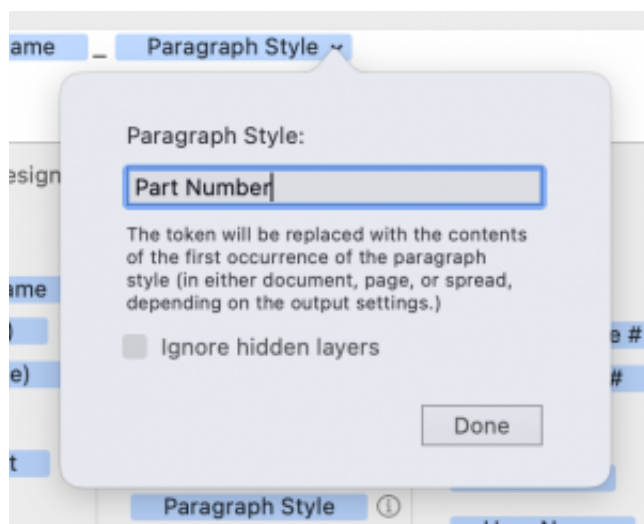

Output Factory can be purchased from the Zevrix website for US\$169.95 (Lite version \$99.95), as well as from authorized resellers and Adobe Exchange. Trial is also available for download. The upgrade is \$85 for the users of Output Factory 2 (Lite version \$50). Output Factory requires macOS 10.12-27.x and Adobe InDesign CS6-2026.
