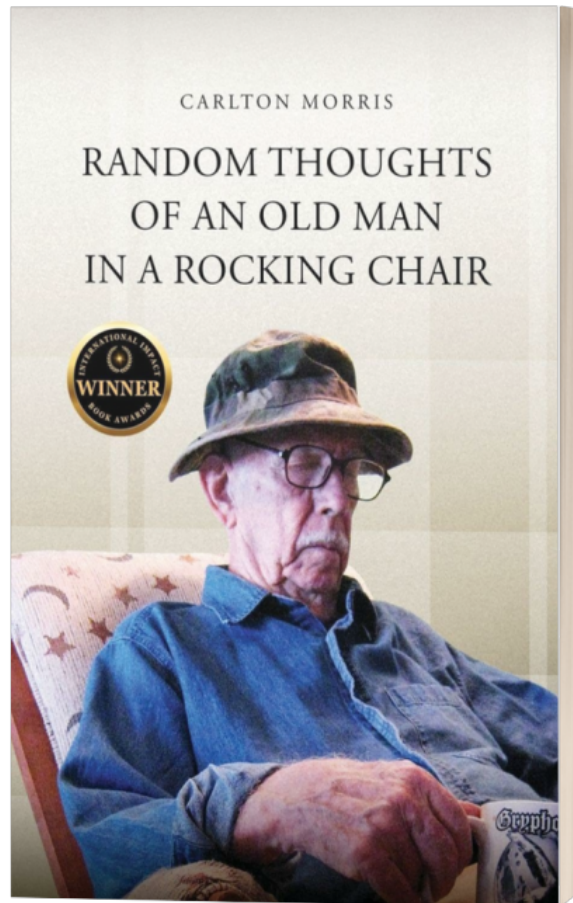


Random Thoughts of an Old Man in a Rocking Chair Reflects on Faith, Survival, and a Lifetime of Experience
