

The History of the Holiday: Dex System Explores 250 Years of Independence Day Traditions

A trivia-rich release timed to the peak of anniversary celebrations

The Fourth wasn't a federal holiday until 1870 — nearly a century after 1776. And the tradition of grilling out didn't take hold nationwide until backyard barbecues boomed in the 1950s. Dex System's thirteenth Semiquincentennial release takes a trivia-filled look at these shifting holiday traditions, pairing that history with titles that explore time, legacy, and reinvention.

Frank Jackson's *The Chrono Accord* plays directly with themes of time and continuity, asking what it means for a system — or a nation — to hold together across centuries. William Benjamin's *The Dream Navigator* and Garth Toxo's *The Elaraeon* extend the holiday's spirit of imagination into new fictional territory, each reimagining what discovery and reinvention can look like when the old maps no longer apply.
