During the BVAT Benchmark 2026, four leading manufacturers — NTA (Elscope Vision), ADI, [Autoscan](#), and HAST — were tasked with performing automated **dent detection** across different vehicle types, paint finishes, and challenging colors including silver, grey, white, and blue.

For most optical AI systems, reflective surfaces remain one of the biggest technical obstacles. Light refraction can easily interfere with sensor interpretation, creating two major operational risks:

- Over-detection (False Positives)
Reflections are mistakenly identified as body damage, leading to inflated repair estimates and unnecessary claims.
- Under-detection (Missed Damage)
Micro dents and subtle defects are overlooked entirely, increasing the risk of arbitration and customer disputes.

These challenges highlight why reproducibility matters so much in modern **automated vehicle inspection** workflows.

Several competing drive-through scanners showed significant sensitivity to reflective paint finishes. Under harsh lighting conditions, some systems frequently over-detected reflections as structural damage.

For operators managing large-scale auctions or fleet inspections, inconsistent detection creates compliance risks and increases operational inefficiencies.

Conservative AI Models and Missed Damage

Some systems attempted to reduce false positives through aggressive AI filtering. However, benchmark data revealed that this often caused substantial under-detection across multiple vehicle colors.

In practical operations, missed dents still require manual verification — limiting the efficiency benefits promised by **automated vehicle inspection** technology.

Sensor Instability and Enterprise Compliance Risks

The benchmark also revealed that certain scanning systems suffered from major volatility between vehicle colors and lighting conditions. For enterprise-level remarketing groups and fleet operators, this lack of consistency can undermine trust in inspection data.
