

China Wheelchair Manufacturer Guide: Top Companies, Industry Clusters, and Sourcing Insights for Two Thousand Twenty-Six

China's wheelchair market is both vast and highly fragmented. More than half of all manufacturers are

capable of producing electric wheelchairs, reflecting the industry's technological evolution. Despite the large number of players, the market remains relatively unconcentrated. In two thousand twenty-five, the top two companies held just eleven point two five percent of the market, and the top four held only thirteen point three eight percent.

However, when viewed by region, the picture is very different. China's wheelchair industry is heavily concentrated along the eastern coast, with five provinces accounting for seventy-two percent of all manufacturers and ten regions accounting for nearly eighty-nine percent. The primary manufacturing hubs are Jiangsu, Guangdong, and Hebei, followed by Shandong, Anhui, and Zhejiang.

The total manual wheelchair market in China reached approximately nine point seven billion yuan in two thousand twenty-five, and is projected to continue growing as the population ages. Electric wheelchairs have also seen strong growth, with the market reaching eight point two three billion yuan in two thousand twenty-five, up six point six percent year-over-year.

Top Wheelchair Manufacturers in China

The "Top Ten" Brands

In two thousand twenty-five, CN10 and CNPP data research, in partnership with Top Ten Brands Network, identified the following as China's top ten wheelchair brands: Hubang, Yuwell, Foshan Wheelchair, Sangui, Kangyang, Kaiyang, Weimeiheng, Ottobock, Kefu, and Fenghuang Medical. These companies represent the industry's most recognized names, though they vary significantly in size, specialization, and market focus.

First-Tier Manufacturers: Scale and Brand Power

The first tier of China's wheelchair industry consists of companies with strong brand recognition, large-scale production lines, and substantial financial resources. Key players include:

Yuwell Medical is the market share leader among listed wheelchair companies, holding approximately seven point five two percent of the overall market in two thousand twenty-five. As a publicly traded company, Yuwell benefits from extensive distribution networks and strong brand recognition across China.

Hubang Intelligent (Shanghai Hubang Intelligent Rehabilitation Equipment Co., Ltd.) was established in nineteen ninety and is one of China's oldest and most established wheelchair manufacturers. The company is a national standard drafting unit for both manual and electric wheelchairs. Hubang operates four modern production facilities totaling over eighty thousand square meters, with an annual production capacity of ninety-seven thousand five hundred units. The company has been actively expanding into international markets, partnering with Europe's largest wheelchair manufacturer MEYRA and Japan's largest custom wheelchair manufacturer. In two thousand twenty-five, Hubang launched its "Magnesium Shadow" electric wheelchair, featuring an integrated die-cast magnesium alloy frame that eliminates traditional welding and significantly reduces weight. The company's full carbon fiber electric wheelchair weighs just ten point five kilograms with a range of forty kilometers.

Foshan Dongfang Medical Equipment Factory has been focused on rehabilitation aids for over thirty-five years. The company produces more than one point five million wheelchairs annually and exports to over one hundred countries and regions. It holds the distinction of being the first Chinese wheelchair manufacturer to obtain a CE certificate, back in nineteen ninety-nine. In two thousand twenty-

five, Dongfang Medical served as the exclusive wheelchair supplier for the National Paralympic Games, providing over two thousand units across all competition venues.

Dayang Medical and **Kaiyang Medical** are also prominent first-tier players. According to two thousand twenty-four export data, Dayang Medical ranked first among Chinese companies in medical wheelchair export value, followed by Kaiyang Medical in second place.

Kefu Medical and **Intco Medical** are publicly listed companies with significant wheelchair operations. Intco Medical produced eight hundred forty thousand wheelchairs in two thousand twenty-four, while Kefu Medical reported gross margins of approximately sixty-one point nine nine percent on its related businesses.

Second-Tier Manufacturers: Branded Players with OEM Capabilities

The second tier consists of companies with established brands that also engage in OEM manufacturing. These firms have solid market reputations and moderate financial strength. Examples include **Sangui**, **Kangyang**, and **Weimeiheng**. **Zhongjin Medical** is another notable player in the manual wheelchair segment.

Specialized and Niche Manufacturers

Beyond the large-scale players, China is home to a growing number of specialized manufacturers focusing on specific market segments.

Pingfang Wheelchair (Changshu Pingfang Wheelchair Co., Ltd.), founded in two thousand ten, has expanded from basic manual wheelchairs to more than ten premium products including smart electric and competition-specific wheelchairs. The company holds seven national invention patents and sixteen utility model patents, and has obtained ISO 13485:2016 and EU CE certification.

Shunkangda Medical Technology (Foshan Shunkangda Medical Technology Co., Ltd.) operates a thirty-thousand-square-meter facility with over three hundred employees and an annual production capacity of three hundred thousand wheelchairs. The company exports to more than fifty countries and regions and holds ISO 9001, CE, and FDA certifications.

Topmedi (Guangzhou Topmedi Co., Ltd.), established in two thousand four, is a leading manufacturer specializing in innovative mobility solutions. The company's product portfolio includes electric wheelchairs, manual wheelchairs, sports wheelchairs, commode chairs, mobility scooters, walking aids, patient transfer machines, and hospital beds. Topmedi has distinguished itself through lightweight carbon fiber and magnesium alloy designs, with products accepted in over one hundred countries. The company's sports wheelchair line—including basketball, tennis, racing, and badminton models—has earned recognition from athletes worldwide.

Publicly Listed Companies in the Wheelchair Sector

Key publicly listed companies in China's wheelchair industry include **Yuwell Medical**, **Kefu Medical**, **Intco Medical**, **Yingluohua**, and **Xinlong Health**. Among these, Yingluohua has the highest registered capital, while Xinlong Health is the earliest established and derives nearly fifty percent of its revenue from overseas markets. Yuwell Medical's wheelchair-related business revenue exceeds one point one billion yuan.

Key Manufacturing Clusters

China's wheelchair industry is organized into several regional clusters, each with distinct advantages.

Guangdong Province: Innovation and Scale

Guangdong, home to cities like Foshan, Guangzhou, and Zhongshan, is the heart of China's wheelchair industry. The province leads in research and development, with manufacturers specializing in smart wheelchairs, lightweight alloys, and customizable designs. The presence of advanced electronics and engineering talent enables faster prototyping and integration of features such as Bluetooth controls, posture sensors, and app-based monitoring systems. Proximity to the ports of Guangzhou and Shenzhen also ensures efficient export logistics.

Foshan, in particular, is often described as the "heart" of China's wheelchair manufacturing, hosting Dongfang Medical, Dayang Medical, Kaiyang Medical, and numerous other industry leaders. The city benefits from a complete supply chain covering everything from aluminum and rubber to electronic components.

Hebei Province: Cost-Effective Production

Hebei has emerged as a major hub for wheelchair manufacturing, particularly around Shijiazhuang and Hengshui. The region offers competitive labor costs, streamlined supply chains, and proximity to Beijing and Tianjin ports. Manufacturers here typically focus on durable, mid-range manual and electric wheelchairs suitable for bulk orders. Hengshui has become a concentrated center for medical equipment production, particularly in manual and lightweight wheelchairs.

Jiangsu and Zhejiang: Integrated Supply Chains and Innovation

Jiangsu and Zhejiang provinces benefit from tightly integrated supply chains and proximity to major ports. The Ningbo area, in particular, offers shorter lead times and lower shipping costs for international shipments. Manufacturers in this cluster often serve large-volume clients across Europe and North America, with many holding CE, FDA, and ISO 13485 certifications. These eastern provinces are also home to innovators focused on ultra-lightweight designs, smart integration, and custom configurations.

How to Choose the Right Manufacturer

For B2B buyers sourcing from China, the following criteria are essential for evaluating potential partners.

Certifications

Ensure suppliers hold relevant certifications: ISO 9001 for quality management, ISO 13485 for medical devices, CE marking for European markets, and FDA registration or MDSAP certification for the United States. These credentials indicate adherence to international safety and quality standards.

Manufacturer vs. Trading Company

Whenever possible, prioritize direct partnerships with manufacturers rather than trading companies. Manufacturers maintain control over production lines, material sourcing, quality inspections, and customization processes, reducing risks and improving transparency.

Production Capacity

Cross-check factory size, staff count, and monthly output. Facilities over twenty thousand square meters with over two hundred employees can typically support large-scale contracts reliably.

Quality Control

Request documentation on material traceability, load testing (standard range: one hundred to one hundred thirty kilograms), and durability tests (minimum ten thousand folding cycles). Third-party lab reports add credibility.

Delivery Performance

Aim for suppliers with on-time delivery rates of ninety-five percent or higher. Consistent punctuality reduces inventory risks and supports just-in-time operations.

Product Specialization

Match the manufacturer's strengths to your product needs. For lightweight and smart wheelchairs, Guangdong-based manufacturers are strong choices. For cost-effective bulk orders, Hebei-based suppliers offer excellent value. For ultra-lightweight and custom solutions, Jiangsu and Zhejiang firms are worth exploring.

Industry Trends to Watch

Several trends are shaping the future of China's wheelchair industry.

Lightweight Materials: Carbon fiber, magnesium alloy, and aerospace-grade aluminum are becoming increasingly common. Manufacturers are competing to produce the lightest possible wheelchairs without compromising strength or safety.

Smart Integration: IoT-enabled wheelchairs with health monitoring, navigation assistance, and remote care capabilities are gaining traction.

Export Growth: China's medical wheelchair exports reached one point eight four nine billion yuan in the first quarter of two thousand twenty-five, up two point eight percent year-over-year. Full-year exports are projected to reach eight point four zero seven billion yuan.

Aging Population: As China's population ages, demand for both manual and electric wheelchairs continues to rise, driving market growth and innovation.
