Instead, the U.S. version supplements its fighting schedule with strategic partnerships to bring in varied programming. This includes offering an extensive library of free global soccer via its FIFA+ integration. You can also catch niche events spanning everything from FIBA basketball on Courtside 1891 to live esports and powerboat racing, making it a surprisingly eclectic mix of global athletics. DAZN holds appeal for die-hard boxing and MMA fans. But its current pricing structure prompted me to reconsider DAZN's overall worthiness for the average viewer. Sure, the service continues to shine with its distribution of marquee fights and the introduction of its all-inclusive Ultimate tier.

DAZN splits its subscriptions into Standard and Ultimate weight classes. The Standard tier gets you ringside for regular fight nights and all other sports, but you still have to pay extra for premium pay-per-view (PPV) events. You can choose the DAZN Standard (Monthly Flex) for \$30.99 a month, or lock in the DAZN Standard (Annual Upfront) for \$224.99 a year. There's also an Annual Installment option that costs \$20.99 a month for 12 months.

DAZN Ultimate is the heavyweight option. It packs a serious punch by bundling at least 12 premium PPVs into your annual plan alongside HDR video and Dolby 5.1 surround sound. It's a steeper investment, but it delivers the best savings compared to buying those marquee bouts separately.

Pay-per-view on DAZN

Throughout the year, DAZN designates select high-profile fights as pay-per-view events. If you're on the DAZN Standard tier, these premium bouts come with a varying added cost, separate from the standard subscription fee — typically around \$69.99 per event. Upgrading to the DAZN Ultimate tier eliminates this headache by including at least 12 PPV events per year at no extra cost.

What to expect from live sports and originals on DAZN

Its main attraction is its coverage of combat sports from renowned fight promoters like Golden Boy and Matchroom Sport. Plus, soccer fans can enjoy live FIFA Club World Cup matches, FIFA+ content, and select games from Liga F, Feminine Division 1, and the Frauen Bundesliga. What makes DAZN particularly unique is its commitment to unconventional sports like chess, darts, and pool. Furthermore, DAZN features on-demand extreme sports courtesy of its partnership with Red Bull TV and global basketball action via FIBA's Courtside 1891.
