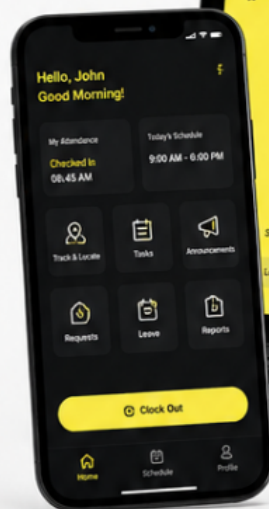

The pitch is simple: give managers, supervisors and field employees one place to see what's actually happening across every job site, instead of piecing it together from five different tools. GPS-verified attendance. Shift scheduling. Payroll. Live tracking. Incident reports. SOS alerts. All of it now sits inside a single dashboard.

Anyone who has managed a team spread across multiple sites knows the drill. A supervisor can only be in one place. Attendance gets fudged, sometimes by accident, sometimes not. Payroll numbers rarely match the hours someone actually worked, and reconciling that mess eats into a manager's week, every single pay period. Then there's the 2 a.m. problem: something goes wrong at a remote site, and the person who needs to know finds out twenty minutes too late. Security companies, patrol services, facility management firms, field service crews: all of them have built workarounds for this. None of the workarounds are great.

DPS Airem's bet is that the fix isn't more paperwork. It's better visibility, delivered as things actually happen. Geofencing checks that a clock-in happened where it was supposed to happen, not just that someone tapped a button somewhere. Managers watch live location data across every site from one web dashboard. Supervisors and employees get the same picture on their phones. Attendance data feeds straight into payroll, so nobody spends Friday afternoon cross-checking timesheets against GPS logs by hand. And when something does go wrong in the field, an employee can file an incident report or hit SOS without scrambling for a number nobody remembers under pressure.

Early users are already describing a shift in how their day-to-day actually runs.

"Managing multiple field teams used to take hours every day," said Colton Reeves, Operations Director at Virexon Security Group. "DPS Airem helped us organize shifts, attendance and reporting without the usual confusion."

Darius Holloway put it a little differently. The Co-Founder of Stravik Patrol Services said the change was obvious almost immediately: *"We started using DPS Airem for our security staff and the difference was noticeable within the first week. The tracking and scheduling features are actually practical and easy to manage."*

Lennox Mercer, Managing Partner at Norvex Field Solutions, noticed something simpler: fewer phone calls. *"The app keeps our supervisors and guards connected throughout the shift," he said. "It's straightforward, reliable, and saves us a lot of back-and-forth calls."*
