The consequences of those events continued long after the war ended. Although peace eventually returns, Mary carries forward the lessons she learned during those uncertain days, discovering that courage is not always found in grand acts of heroism but often in quiet choices made for others.

Monti's narrative moves with the lean economy of an oral tale, anchoring its historical backdrop in vivid, tangible details—a bowl of grits and a single egg, a traveling pie pressed into a departing knight's hands, and the steady rhythm of work on a struggling farm. The result is a medieval adventure that never loses sight of its emotional core: courage found not on the battlefield, but in ordinary people who refuse to turn away from hardship.

Suitable for readers of all ages, *Mary and Sir Edward* pairs the texture of historical fiction with the warmth and clarity of a story meant to be shared across generations.

The newly released trailer brings this world to life through cinematic imagery of Mary's farm, Sir Edward's arrival, and the quiet heroism at the center of the story, offering viewers a visual introduction to the novel's atmosphere and emotional stakes.
