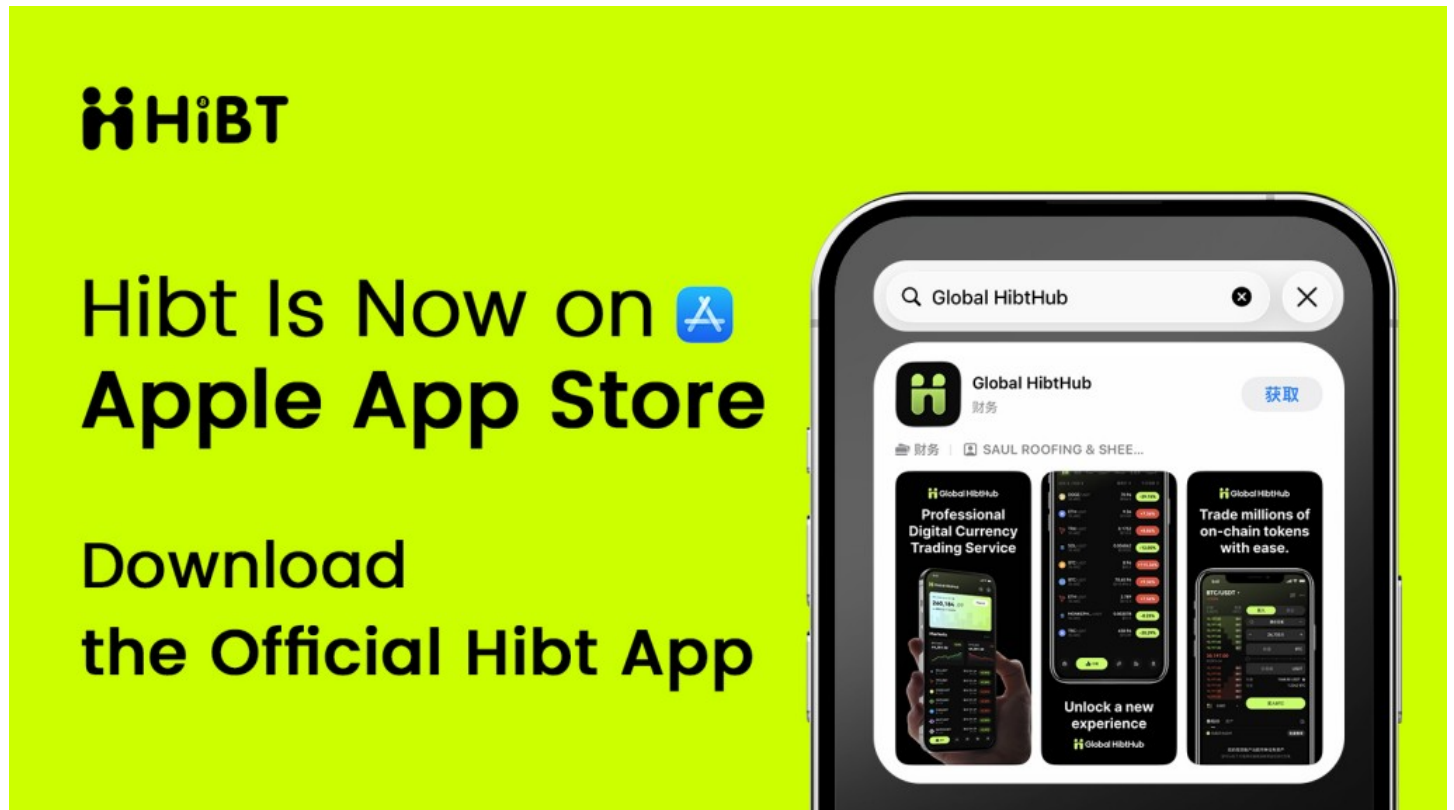


Hibt Announces Global HibtHub Is Now Available on the Apple App Store in 13 Regions

Apple's review process and Hibt's financial regulatory licences or registrations in the United States, Canada and Australia add a clear compliance signal to the iPhone rollout.

The rollout covers India, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, Nigeria, Brazil, the United States, Hong Kong SAR, Canada, Australia, Türkiye, South Korea and Japan. By making the supported regions clear, [Hibt](#) gives users, communities and regional partners a precise reference point for current iPhone availability.

The App Store page places **Global HibtHub** in the **Finance category** and identifies it as a free app designed for iPhone. The process also includes security checks designed to identify malware and software behavior that could affect users. These standards are described in Apple's [App Review Guidelines](#).

For a finance-category application, completing this process carries practical significance. It shows that the submitted version passed Apple's platform review and met the publication requirements in effect at the time of approval. The result is a visible **app-distribution compliance signal** that users can recognize before installing the software.

The App Store listing also improves transparency by presenting core information in a consistent format. Users can see the app name, category, system requirements, privacy disclosures and update history without moving between multiple sources. For [Hibt](#), this supports a more open and verifiable mobile distribution experience while reinforcing its focus on product quality, user protection and operational standards.

Hibt has also obtained financial regulatory licences or registrations in the United States, Canada and Australia, further strengthening its global compliance framework.

The 13-region launch expands Hibt's mobile presence across Asia, Africa, Latin America, North America and Oceania. It also gives local communities a concise message to share: search Global HibtHub on the Apple App Store. That clarity is especially valuable when users encounter the platform through news coverage, community announcements or search results.

Global HibtHub is available through the Apple App Store in India, Vietnam, Thailand, Indonesia, Nigeria, Brazil, the United States, Hong Kong SAR, Canada, Australia, Türkiye, South Korea and Japan. According to the current listing, the app supports English and requires iOS 13.0 or later. Users can search Global HibtHub directly in a supported App Store region.
