III. Technical Innovation in Detection: Precision Sensing and Multi-Protocol Connectivity

The core of effective carbon monoxide defense lies in sensor chemistry and digital processing stability. ARIZA incorporates state-of-the-art electrochemical sensors designed specifically for selective gas response. Unlike older semiconductor sensors that suffer from cross-sensitivity to household cleaning vapors, cooking fumes, or humidity shifts, electrochemical detection operates through gas-specific chemical reactions that generate electrical currents directly proportional to ambient CO volume.

- This electrochemical accuracy is coupled with intelligent firmware algorithms designed to comply with European and North American response curves. Under standard EN50291-1 test protocols, the system executes tiered alarm triggers based on exposure concentration over time:
- At concentrations exceeding 50 PPM, the alarm triggers within 60 to 90 minutes, capturing low-level leaks before physiological damage occurs.
- At concentrations exceeding 100 PPM, response time narrows to between 10 and 40 minutes.
- At critical concentrations exceeding 300 PPM, the device initiates immediate emergency alerts within 0 to 3 minutes.

To complement local hardware detection, ARIZA integrates modern wireless communication architecture into its detection family. Utilizing optimized Tuya Wi-Fi and Smart Life IoT modules operating on standard 2.4GHz frequencies, the system enables direct cloud connectivity without requiring secondary hub hardware. In the event of a gas anomaly, the device concurrently triggers an

85dB local acoustic sounder measured at 3 meters and dispatches real-time push notifications to registered mobile applications.

Crucially, the architecture prioritizes fail-safe operation. If local Wi-Fi connectivity experiences network downtime or router power failures, the detector continues to function autonomously as a standalone physical life-safety monitor, maintaining continuous local sound and light warnings via natural diffusion sampling. Once network service is restored, remote sync re-establishes automatically.
