

# MRM Business Solutions Expands U.S. Corporate Compliance, E-Notary, Apostille & Cross-Border Document Services

Strategic alliance connects corporate filings, Registered Agent Services, UCC and public-record research, E-Notary, apostille, authentication, consular legalization and international document processing through a single B2B service network.

They require coordinated corporate filings, due diligence, document retrieval, notarization, authentication, apostille, and jurisdiction-specific processing across the United States and internationally. MRM Business Solutions has developed an integrated professional-services network designed to help U.S. and international law firms, corporate service providers, and professional organizations manage those requirements without building additional internal departments or maintaining numerous vendor relationships.

MRM Business Solutions was developed through the strategic relationship of CA Corporate & Attorney Services Inc. (CCAS) and Professional Filing & Search Services Inc. (PFSS), with MRM Business E-Notary powered by eNotary On Call technology. Together, the network connects U.S. corporate services, nationwide filing and research capabilities, Remote Online Notarization and international document processing.

## GLOBAL DOCUMENT INFRASTRUCTURE CONTINUES TO EXPAND

The launch comes as the international framework supporting cross-border use of public documents continues to expand and digitalize. The Hague Conference on Private International Law reports that the 1961 Apostille Convention has reached 130 Contracting Parties. Algeria became the latest country for which the Convention entered into force in July 2026. Digitalization is advancing alongside that expansion. According to 2026 information from the Hague Conference, 59 Contracting Parties had implemented one or both components of the electronic Apostille Programme (e-APP) by the end of 2025, with 42 implementing both components. The e-APP supports electronic Apostilles and electronic registers used to verify Apostilles.

Remote Online Notarization is another component of the shift toward digital document execution. An independent 2025 market analysis valued the global Remote Online Notary services market at approximately \$137 million for 2025 and projected compound annual growth of approximately 17.1% through 2033. These developments increase the need for professional infrastructure capable of coordinating document execution, corporate records, certification, apostille, authentication, and consular legalization across jurisdictions.

## A U.S. RESOURCE FOR INTERNATIONAL LAW FIRMS

For an international law firm representing a client entering or conducting business in the United States, a single matter may require entity formation or qualification, Registered Agent Services, Secretary of State filings, certified corporate documents, UCC due diligence and continuing compliance support. For U.S. firms representing clients internationally, documents executed domestically may require notarization, certification, apostille, authentication or consular legalization before being presented abroad. MRM connects both sides of that workflow, providing a U.S.-based resource capable of supporting operational requirements before, during and after cross-border transactions.

MRM Business E-Notary, powered by eNotary On Call technology, provides Remote Online Notarization capabilities for eligible transactions, including live audio-video notarization, identity verification, credential analysis, electronic signatures, digital notarial seals, encryption and transaction audit records, subject to applicable jurisdictional requirements. Law firms can provide clients access to remote notarization capabilities without managing additional technology infrastructure. When documents are intended for international use, the MRM network can coordinate subsequent apostille, authentication or consular legalization requirements. Through CCAS, the network supports international corporate transactions, powers of attorney, corporate resolutions, commercial agreements, foreign subsidiaries, overseas real estate matters and documents presented to foreign governmental authorities.

"Cross-border matters often involve far more than obtaining a signature or completing a filing," said Rosie Laloyan, Vice President & Director of Consular and International Services, CA Corporate & Attorney Services Inc. "Our objective is to help law firms and professional organizations coordinate the process through an experienced U.S.-based resource."

## ONE RELATIONSHIP. MULTIPLE TRANSACTION REQUIREMENTS.

The MRM model addresses a fragmented professional-services environment in which one matter may otherwise require separate providers for corporate filings, public-record research, Registered Agent Services, notarization, apostille processing and international authentication. The network encompasses entity formations, foreign qualifications, Registered Agent Services, Secretary of State filings, UCC searches and filings, lien and judgment searches, good-standing research, certified corporate documents, public-record research, apostilles, authentication, consular legalization and E-Notary services. For firms handling recurring multi-state or international matters, coordinating these capabilities through one broader network can reduce the administrative burden of managing multiple vendors.

MRM Business Solutions is structured to function as an extension of a law firm's administrative and transactional workflow, not as a replacement for legal counsel. For international firms, MRM can provide U.S. corporate and document-processing infrastructure behind transactions. For domestic firms, MRM can support requirements arising when client matters cross international borders. Attorneys manage the legal strategy. MRM helps manage the corporate and document-processing infrastructure required to move the transaction forward. MRM's model extends beyond individual document orders. The network is positioned for outsourced fulfillment, referral relationships, institutional accounts and recurring transaction support with law firms, corporate service companies, registered agent providers and other professional organizations seeking additional U.S. or international processing capabilities.
