Pest Control Tucson, located at 850 W Auto Mall Dr, is expanding its residential and commercial service coverage across Pima County. The company treats the pest pressure that comes with living in the Sonoran Desert: bark scorpions, subterranean and drywood termites, roof rats, Africanized honeybees, and kissing bugs (*Triatoma* species), the insect the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention links to

Chagas disease in rare Southern Arizona cases.

Why Tucson Properties See Pest Activity Year-Round

Tucson's climate does not give homeowners an off-season. The University of Arizona Cooperative Extension notes that bark scorpions remain active whenever nighttime temperatures stay above roughly 70 degrees, which in Tucson can run from March through October. Termites keep foraging underground even in summer heat, and packrats move into attics, garages, and parked vehicles as monsoon season pushes them out of washes and open desert. Neighborhoods bordering desert washes, such as parts of the Catalina Foothills, Sabino Canyon, and the areas around Saguaro National Park, tend to see heavier scorpion and packrat pressure than midtown blocks near Speedway Boulevard or Sam Hughes.

Pest Control Tucson technicians are trained to identify which of these patterns applies to a specific address before recommending treatment, rather than applying the same seasonal package to every property regardless of location.

Inspection Before Treatment

Every service call starts with a walk-through of the structure and yard to identify the pest, the entry points, and the conditions drawing it in, cracked stucco, gaps under garage doors, standing water, woodpiles against the foundation, or open block cores common in older Tucson construction. Technicians are licensed through the Arizona Department of Agriculture's structural pest control program, and the company states its treatment plans are built around what the inspection finds rather than a fixed, one-size service tier.

"A house near a wash and a house in a newer subdivision don't have the same scorpion pressure, so they shouldn't get the same treatment plan," said [Owner/Spokesperson Name], [Title] at Pest Control Tucson. "We start with the inspection, tell the customer exactly what we found, and build the plan from there."

Services Covered

Pest Control Tucson provides extermination and exclusion services for stinging and biting pests common to the region, including bark scorpions, Africanized honeybees, wasps, hornets, and kissing bugs. The company also handles wood-destroying pests, treating both subterranean and drywood termites, and offers rodent control for roof rats, pack rats, and house mice. General insect service covers cockroaches, ants, fleas, ticks, beetles, and mosquitoes, and technicians also respond to snake encounters and nuisance bird issues on residential and commercial properties.

Treatment plans include exterior sealing at identified entry points, monitoring stations where appropriate, and scheduled follow-up visits rather than a single treatment with no return service.

Common Questions About Tucson Pest Control

How often does a Tucson home need pest control? Most homes in Pima County are treated on a quarterly schedule, with more frequent visits during peak scorpion season (roughly April through September) for properties near desert washes or open land.

Are scorpion treatments safe for kids and pets? Pest Control Tucson uses products labeled for residential use around children and pets when applied according to label instructions; the technician

reviews product labels and any household-specific concerns during the initial inspection.

Does Pest Control Tucson treat termites separately from general pests? Yes. Termite inspection and treatment follows a separate protocol from general pest service, since termite activity is usually confirmed with a targeted inspection rather than caught during a routine spray visit.

Company Statement

"Solving a Tucson pest problem takes more than a standard spray," he said. "We look at why the pest is there in the first place, fix that, and stay in contact after the first visit so the problem doesn't come back."
