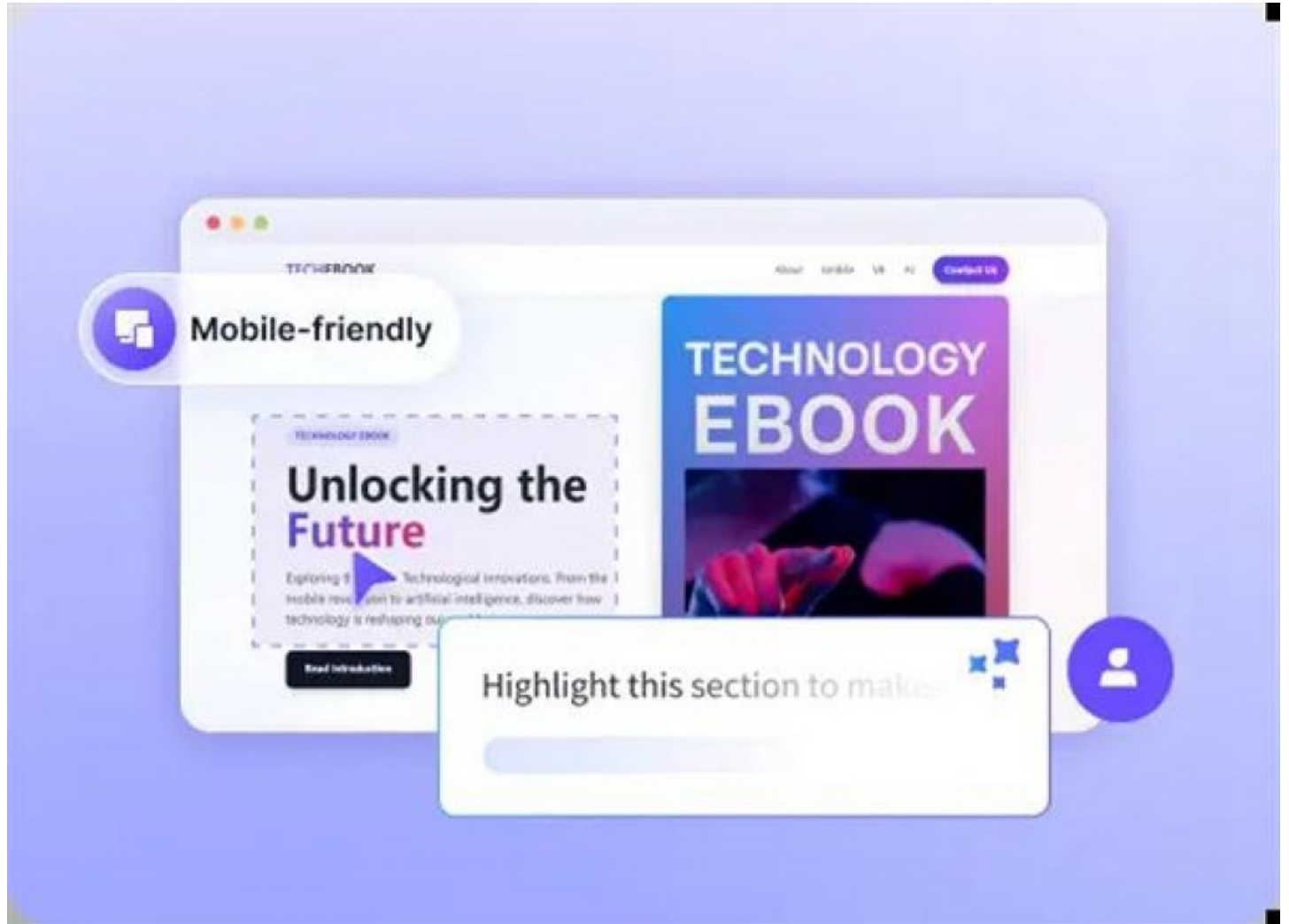


Recastia's PDF to Video AI Helps Course Creators Publish Lessons Faster

Recastia's PDF to video AI converts existing documents into narrated, captioned clips, giving course creators, marketers, and trainers a way to publish video without editing software.

[Recastia](https://www.recastia.com) offers PDF to video AI that gives each of them a way to convert those files into narrated clips without touching a video editor. The feature reads the uploaded pages and rebuilds them as a spoken, captioned video that suits how their audiences prefer to learn.

For the course creator, converting a PDF to video with AI starts by uploading a lesson file. Recastia drafts a narration script from the text on each page, then reads it aloud in a synthetic voice while matching on-screen wording to the audio. The creator can rewrite any part of the script before generating, so the finished lesson explains concepts in their own words rather than a flat readout of the slides.

The product marketer leans on the same AI PDF to video workflow but dresses the output differently. An

on-screen avatar can present the pitch, a page-turn style transition can move between sections, and a soundtrack can set the tone for a launch clip. Because these choices are made at generation time, the marketer can produce several versions of one deck for different campaigns without redoing the source file.

For the HR lead, [PDF to video AI](#) offers a range of production levels to match each onboarding topic. A quiet, auto-advancing version works for a lobby screen, a narrated version with automatic page timing fits a self-paced module, and a slower page-by-page reading suits compliance material that staff need to absorb carefully.

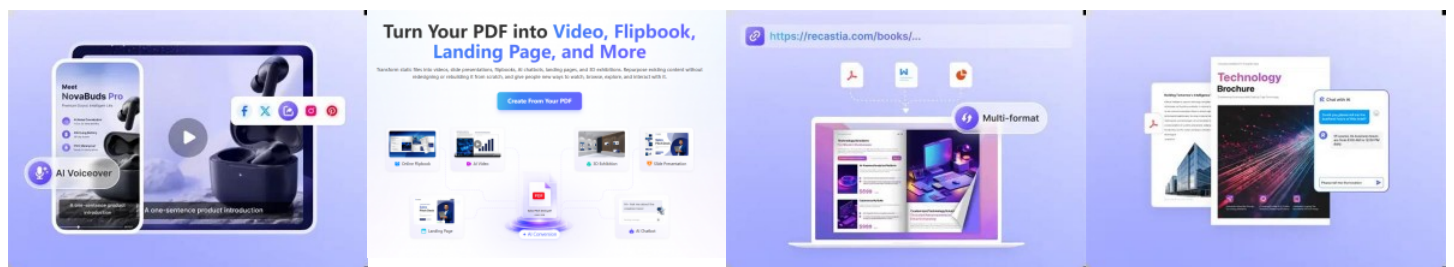
Once any of these clips is generated, the AI PDF to video output is published to a web link the team can send out immediately. Viewers open it in a browser, and the same clip can be embedded in a course portal, a product page, or an internal wiki. A single upload can even branch into other formats, such as a browsable flipbook or a question-answering chatbot, when a team wants more than video from the same document.

"Video is where a lot of audiences now spend their attention, but most teams do not have hours to edit it. Our PDF to video AI lets them start from a finished document and reach that audience the same day," said Winston Zhang, CEO of Recastia.
