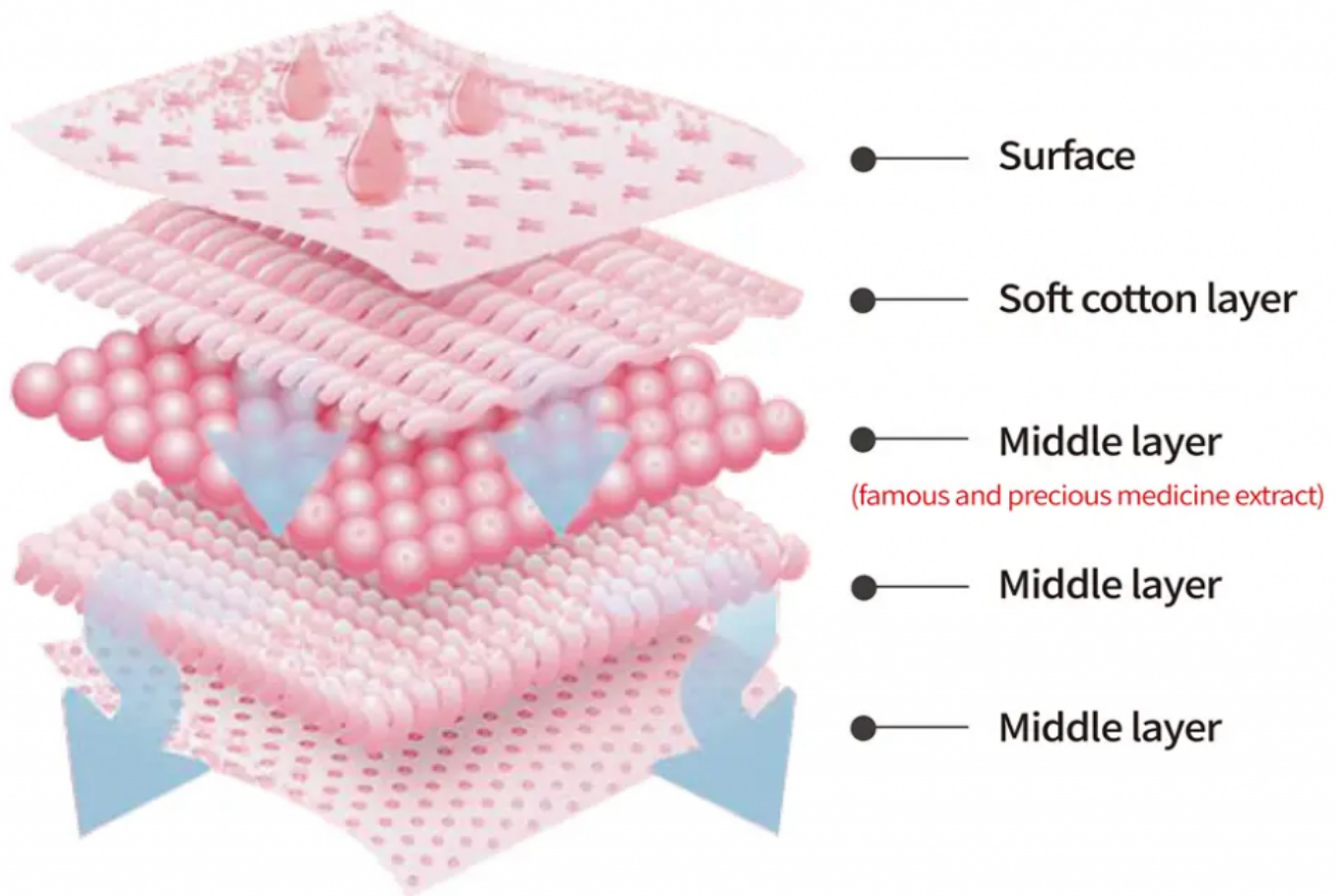


The Triple Barrier: Understanding Zimeishu's Comprehensive Protection System
