Critically, the United States NFRC rating or EU CE marking carry no legal recognition under Australian building law. Only AS2047-compliant products, verified by accredited testing, satisfy the NCC. For builders sourcing from international manufacturers, this distinction matters enormously. Selecting an overseas supplier without verified AS2047 certification exposes a project to legal and financial liability, potential structural failure, and significant delays if products are rejected by building inspectors on site.

This compliance gateway is also why not every Chinese or European manufacturer that produces excellent windows can be considered a viable aluminium window supplier for Australian construction projects.
