Atlanta, Georgia Sep 2, 2026 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - 1st Treasure Chara Centers is offering a 120-hour Phlebotomy Technician program in Holly Springs that gives students dedicated laboratory time to practice the procedures behind safe and accurate blood collection.

The program separates training into 80 hours of theory and 40 hours of laboratory instruction. Students first build an understanding of the circulatory system, infection control, specimen requirements, patient assessment, and workplace safety, then apply those concepts through practical exercises.

A major part of the course centers on venipuncture and capillary puncture. Students learn how to assess potential collection sites, use common phlebotomy equipment, and follow appropriate procedures for drawing blood. Training continues beyond the collection itself, covering specimen labeling, handling, and transportation.

The course also addresses a part of phlebotomy that technical instruction can sometimes overlook: the patient experience.

Blood draws can make patients nervous. Phlebotomy technicians need to explain what is happening, respond to questions, and carry out the procedure without losing attention to safety or accuracy. The curriculum at 1st Treasure Chara Centers includes patient communication and reassurance alongside

technical practice.

Laboratory safety forms another core component. Students become familiar with needles, tourniquets, blood collection tubes, infection-prevention procedures, and protocols intended to protect both patients and healthcare workers.

For individuals considering phlebotomy certification in Georgia, the program provides a local training option in Cherokee County, with Holly Springs accessible from communities including Canton, Woodstock, Acworth, Marietta, and other areas of North Georgia.

Applicants must be at least 17 years old and hold a high school diploma, GED, or international high school diploma equivalency. The school also lists a government-issued ID, Social Security card, and Hepatitis B vaccination among its enrollment requirements.

Current tuition for the Phlebotomy Technician program is \$1,350. The school lists lab supplies at \$125 and a separate \$125 registration fee, while the textbook, workbook, uniform, and lab kit are included with tuition.
