The third evaluates whether, on balance, it would benefit the United States to waive the job offer and labor certification requirements.

AAE Evaluations structures its EB-2 NIW expert opinion letters around these considerations, using the applicant's professional achievements and supporting evidence to develop a field-specific assessment.
