

## **Almond Tree Security Services now protects South Florida construction sites**

The Homestead-based agency provides static officers and mobile patrols to reduce after-hours theft of tools, equipment and materials on active job sites.

licensed Florida security and private investigation agency, is now providing [construction site security](#) to general contractors, developers and property owners across Miami-Dade, Broward and Monroe counties. The company added the service because active job sites hold large amounts of equipment and materials that sit unattended once crews leave for the day, which makes them a frequent target for theft and trespassing.

Construction site security from ATSS can be arranged as a static officer posted at the site, as [scheduled mobile patrols](#), or as a combination of both. Officers control access to the site after hours, check fencing, gates and storage areas, and document each shift in an incident report that the contractor can review. Coverage can be set for a single phase of a project, such as the period when appliances, wiring or fixtures are delivered and installed, or for the full length of the build.

ATSS notes that an officer on site works best alongside basic physical measures. Perimeter fencing, lighting, locked storage and an up-to-date equipment inventory all make a site harder to target, and an officer cannot fully protect a site that is left open or unlit. The company reviews these measures with contractors when planning coverage so that staffing matches the actual risk on each site.

Because projects change quickly, response time is part of the service. ATSS responds to new requests within two hours and can deploy officers within four hours, 24 hours a day, which allows contractors to add coverage when a delivery arrives early or a site is exposed after a storm or an incident.

"A job site is most exposed between the time the crew leaves and the time they come back, and that is when most contractors have nobody watching it," said Brian Kennedy, CEO of Almond Tree Security Services. "Our role is to cover those hours with licensed officers and give the contractor a clear record of what happened overnight."

Every ATSS officer holds both a Florida Class D (unarmed) and Class G (armed) security license and completes 40 hours of initial field training alongside an experienced officer, followed by annual training in de-escalation and sexual harassment prevention. The company operates under Florida Security Agency License B 3500420 and Private Investigator Agency License A 3500419, and is certified by the State of Florida as a Veteran Preference Company.
