"A lot of homeowners think of sealing as purely cosmetic — something done to make a driveway or patio look better," the company said. "In Tampa Bay, proper sealing can also play an important role in protecting surfaces from repeated moisture exposure and long-term deterioration."

Warning Signs Homeowners Should Not Ignore

Tampa Terrazzo recommends that homeowners inspect exterior surfaces for early signs of wear, including:

- **Surface pitting or flaking:** Small pockmarks or a sandy, deteriorating texture on concrete surfaces.
- **Standing water after rain:** Persistent pooling that may indicate drainage, settling, or surface issues.
- **Shifting or uneven pavers:** Gaps caused by washed-out joint sand or pavers that move underfoot.
- **Discoloration or dark staining:** Potential signs of moisture retention, mineral deposits, mold, or algae growth.
- **Hairline cracks:** Small cracks that can worsen when moisture repeatedly penetrates beneath the surface.

Addressing these issues early may help homeowners avoid more extensive restoration work later.
